- Letter from Roy Blake circulated on traffic congestion Capel Street/Winehouse Lane area due to building works. *Action: To ask Community Warden to monitor in first instance.*

- Closure of Capel Street (from Hurst Lane/Winehouse Lane) in New Year by Affinity Water for works. Concerns expressed on traffic diversions and farm milk lorry access.

6. PLANNING

a) Pending Applications

Applications waiting Dover District Council Decision

- 17/01324, Erection of dormer roof extensions to front and side roof slopes, 28 Helena Road, Capel-le-Ferne, CT18 7LQ. Resolved: No valid planning objections, so the Parish Council support this application with the following condition: The proposed alterations need neighbour's input, as the design of the roofs looks a bit odd and there may be an overlooking/privacy issue given the small separation between the rear of 26 and the front of 28 with the front elevation dormer window overlooking 26 Helena Road. The Bathroom windows need to be obscure glass with limited opening.
- 17/01190, Erection of a single storey rear extension, rear dormer roof extension with Juliette balcony and 2 front roof lights and replace existing brickwork to all elevations, 145 Capel Street, Capel-le-Ferne, CT18 7HA. Resolved: Capel-le-Ferne Parish Council feel unable to comment on the plans submitted with this application, due to the confusion that the plans presented, do not reflect the existing. Assuming this is a retrospective application. The plans show the front roof lights to exist already, are they being replaced or is this an error on the drawings?

If permitted, it would appear to be the only bungalow on this part of Capel Street with a dormer extension, which can be seen from the rear gardens of neighbouring properties and could create overlooking issues.

• <u>17/00838</u>, Erection of a detached dwelling, formation of vehicular access, driveway and parking, Site Adjacent, 128 Capel Street, Capel-le-Ferne, CT18 7HA.

Sale of properties in Capel Street for access

Councillors were concerned about comments in residents' letter, which was shared with them.

Their initial response was one of monitoring the situation extremely closely and when the Dover District Council's Land Allocation Local Plan Review comes up for consultation this year, to check and respond accordingly if the land at the rear of Capel Street is included.

Other comments made were in agreement, that Capel does not have the infrastructure and likewise, Capel Street is not suitable for access for any large development and this was one of the reasons the Land between 107-127 Capel Street was refused by Dover District Council.

Land junction Winehouse Lane and Capel Street

Public Order Diversion Order received for footpath ER243 (Part).

A Consultation will be held 2018 and hopefully a working together partnership with companies will be forthcoming. *Action: Maybe add change of route to take in Blackbull Road.*, *Hospital and Train Station access*.

- Community Transport Grant West Hougham to make a "main bid". Agreed that Capel Parish Council would support this action, hopefully encouraging a working liaison with all three Parishes using, possibly Capel Cares to make use, plus children/youth use, catering and language groups. Idea would be to work on a timetabling, proportionate co-ordinator/driver paid person and to self-fund. *Action: All Councillors present agreed to support this.*
