- 2. **DECLARATION OF PERSONAL INTERESTS None.**
- PUBLIC ADDRESS TO COUNCILLORS None received
 Clerk reported there was one Surgery feedback from Parishioners of trees requiring cut back on PROW.

4. **MINUTES**

The Minutes of the meeting held on 15th September 2015 were proposed as a true record by Cllr. Norris and seconded by Cllr. Shaw and approved. Signed by the Chairman, Cllr. Pilcher.

Chairman expressed thanks to everyone, Councillors and Clerk, for all the efforts put in with relation to the response to Dover District Council Planning Department on the proposed development Land South of New Dover Road.

5. MATTERS ARISING NOT COVERED ELSEWHERE ON AGENDA

- a) Open Space Needs and New Developments
 - Dividing fence on site erected. Earth bunds behind trees constructed as screening.
 - Noted over 50 comments had been submitted by residents.
- b) New Litter Bin, Winehouse Lane Still not in place DDC to make arrangements with Cllr. Tutt to ascertain correct position as agreed with farmer. *Action Cllr. Tutt*.
- c) <u>Casual Vacancy</u> one remaining to be re-advertised in December and February Grapevine issue, together with flyers to be sent out via school. Item will be placed on agenda for February meeting.
- e) Battle of Britain Memorial Trust Bus Shelter Bus stop pole to be repositioned when installation takes place. Agreement by all to order shelter and pay by pro-forma invoice. Stagecoach to be contacted to adjust sign on post on completion. Further application to Kent County Council to acquire extra 50% funding for any additional works required.

 - i. Several vehicles being abandoned in village, some on false plates. Action: These are reported by Paul James and Gretel May, who are closely monitoring situation.
 - *ii.* Roof repairs "Anglian Home Improvements" using a promotion company checked and reported for door step calling.
 - iii. CCTV monitor now moved. Thanks expressed to Paul James for pursuing to a conclusion.
 - *iv.* Condition of wooden bus shelter at Helena Road to be checked following reports of vandalism. *Action Paul James*.
 - v. Police Forum meeting no-one available to attend.
 - vi. Cattle crossing sign (Tumble Tye Farm) Proposed and supported by all present. Action: Paul James to liaise and Clerk to write to Kent Highways.
- b) Play Equipment Status Cllr. Pilcher.
 - i. Query on quotation for replacement of swing chains. *Action: Cllr. Pilcher and Clerk waiting response from Wicksteed.*
 - ii. No contact from Royal Oak on further equipment. Action: Cllr. Stone to write a formal letter.

Report previously circulated.

Annual General Meeting date 23rd November 2015. Agreed by all present to nominate Cllr. Stone as Trustee representative for Parish Council. *Action: Clerk to inform VHMC*.

- *d*) Highways *Cllr. Tutt*.
 - *i.* No major works programmed by Kent Highways for village in 2016/2017. Only minor works will be carried out.
 - *ii.* Footway New Dover Road (north side), no full resurface planned, maybe possible patching and monitoring by Kent Highways.
 - iii. Footway New Dover Road (south side), still no action to reinstate. Action: Clerk to remind Kent Highways of previous correspondence on this.
 - *iv.* Blocked drainage outside 23 Capel Street reported now corrected.
 - v. Cracks in B2011 road surface. Action: to be investigated further by Craig Marsh, Kent Highways.
 - vi. Planters at Courtwood Round and mud on highway reported. Highways Traffic Engineer, Richard Heaps, had replied to queries raised about planters; i.e. statutory distance from carriageway, no need to be painted or planted, maintenance KCC and no plans to provide further. Action: Craig Marsh to pursue road sweeper and to chase the possibility of more planters on bend of road by roundabout. Clerk to highlight further the state of this area with other agencies.
 - vii. HGV parking at Courtwood Roundabout slip road, verges and laybys still a cause for concern. Action: Paul James to make further enquiries with Dover Parking services. Clerk to continue to highlight issue with other agencies, including the installation of "No HGV Parking" signs.
 - viii. Notification received on Capel Street road closure, due to bridge repairs.
 - *ix.* Highway Survey to be completed. Action: *Cllr. Tutt.*
 - x. Closure to traffic of Smallpox Hill (Crete Road East to Dover Hill), due to fly-tipping issues.
 - xi. Notification and report received from Kent and Medway Safety Camera Partnership following their assessment for attendance on B2011 stating "New Dover Road does not meet the criteria for adoption as a temporary site, although there appears to be an issue with excess speed".
 - xii. Still waiting Kent County Council assessment decision on 20mph status in Capel Street.
 - xiii. Still waiting Highway England and other agencies decisions on A20 TAP (Traffic Assessment Phase). Concerns expressed on no further comments being made and the need to pursue the "bigger problem". Action: Clerk to make representations to Highway England for consideration that a Parish Council delegate is present when this issue is re-assessed.
