DRAFT MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF CAPEL-LE-FERNE PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON 20TH NOVEMBER 2018

3. <u>MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 16th OCTOBER 2018</u>

The Minutes of the meeting held on 16th October 2018 were approved and signed by the Chairman, Cllr. Keith Pilcher, proposed by Cllr. Holliday, seconded by Cllr. Tutt.

5. <u>MATTERS ARISING NOT COVERED ELSEWHERE ON AGENDA</u>

a) Traffic Management

Councillors received quotation from Kent Highways on providing 10 roundels in Capel Street. It was agreed to fund 20mph zone reminder roundels on the roads in Capel-le-Ferne. Initially this will be in Capel Street and will be implemented by Kent Highway contractors in the Spring, when weather improves and road surface suitable. Depending on funding availability and monitoring of traffic in Capel Street once the roundels are in place, Councillors will then consider traffic calming roundels in other 20mph zones in Capel-le-Ferne on a rolling programme. Investigations will be undertaken to include all side roads, including Old Dover Road and then New Dover Road (when the speed limit extensions to the 40mph speed zone is organised on Dover Hill and beyond new development on B2011).

Action/Resolution: Further to this pro-active programme, the Parish Council are taking the immediate initiative to order 20mph zone stickers for wheelie bins (free of charge), if residents wish to use them. When received, these will be available from Community Warden and/or Parish Clerk. The use of these has been agreed by Dover District Council and Kent Highways.

b) Village Questionnaire

This was almost complete and hopefully the results document will be available for presentation to Councillors at the next meeting.

- c) <u>Bus Shelter outside Battle of Britain Memorial Site</u> This is anticipated to be completed before Christmas. *Action/Resolution: Clerk to check cleaning of all shelters with Dover District Council.*
- *R*oadside Planters Enquiries made to get the planters removed by Youngs Grounds Maintenance. Cost £60. *Action/Resolution: This amount was agreed. Contractors would supply compost in the Spring, when boxes installed.*
- *e)* <u>2019 KALC Community Award</u> Nomination had been received. *Action/Resolution: To complete KALC Awards form.*
- *f)* <u>Vacancy</u> No nominations received to date. *Action/Resolution: To continue advertising and to create some interest by informal approach.*
