
The effect of the Order would be to extend the 40mph speed limit on the following length of road:

REVOCATION, MODIFICATION AND AMENDMENTS

The "Kent County Council (Various Roads, The District of Dover) (20mph, 30mph, 40mph, 50mph Speed Limits and Derestricted Roads) Consolidation Order 2012" ("the Order of 2012") be amended as follows.

In the Schedule 4 of the Order 2012 the following shall be deleted from the Table below.
