#### *From the Vicarage*

I once heard of a young curate (no, not me) who stood up in church to preach his first ever Remembrance Sunday sermon. He had just begun by asking the congregation to imagine what the Somme must have been like, with its trenches, mud, and shells exploding everywhere when an elderly gentleman rose to his feet. “YOUNG PUPPY! I WAS THERE!” he barked, before storming out.

Growing up, I sometimes heard my father and my uncles talking about their experiences in World War 2. Dad was an ammunition storeman in the Ordnance Corps; one uncle served aboard a minesweeper, another was an officer's batman. But one, who had seen action in Italy, spoke little about what he had done. I remember he mentioned Anzio, and also Monte Cassino. To a small boy, his stories sounded exciting. Only later did I realise the truth: that while still just a teenager he had seen - and done - things that nobody should have to see or do at any age. Returning home, at first he had talked endlessly about one particularly traumatic incident; only his uncle, himself a veteran of the Great War, seemed to understand what he had been through.

This month sees the centenary of the end of World War 1. We are urged to remember. The services that will be held will include not only prayers for those who lost their lives in the world wars and in other conflicts since, but also for peace now and in the future. Thankfully, like that young curate most of us can only imagine trenches, mud, shells and what my uncle and great uncle went through; most of us have been spared the reality. Let's pray that those who come after us may be as fortunate. *Brian*

### Kent County Council Budget Consultation.

This month Kent County Council launches its annual budget consultation with the endeavour to continue to protect the complex services it provides, particularly those that support the most vulnerable in our communities, both young and old, whilst continuing to support economic growth to make Kent a great place to live, work and enjoy. The Autumn Budget Statement will be discussed at the county council meeting on 18<sup>th</sup> October and sets out the challenges the council faces and the need to find further savings of £57million next year out of a net annual revenue budget of £958million.

The proposals, which involve a six-week long consultation, suggest an increase of just under 3% in council tax and a further 2% social care precept to help meet the challenge ahead for the coming financial year. KCC Leader Paul Carter said: "In recent years, with intelligent planning and a great deal of hard work from our staff, we have delivered extraordinary savings to protect and enhance the complex array of services that this authority provides. We have identified a potential £41million of savings so far, but still need to find a further £16million if we are to continue to support good local services for the next financial year and beyond.

However, as part of the government's austerity package, funding for local authorities continues to shrink, demand continues to rise and the scope to make further savings from efficiencies is now very limited. We are waiting for the Chancellor's Autumn Budget to hear more about the final local government settlement in the hope that additional money may be found for next year, but as a responsible local authority we are having to plan for no change. It's encouraging that, post Brexit, the Prime Minister has intimated there will be an end to austerity.

We are listening hard to the voice of Kent residents and there seems to be a real understanding that the public services we all value do need to be protected and that means they must be paid for. The consultation is the chance to tell us if we have got that judgement right."

Peter Oakford, Deputy Leader and Cabinet Member for Finance said: "The council provides a huge range of essential services to the people of Kent. Some of these services, like repairing potholes and running libraries, are visible to just about everyone. Others, like children's services and adult social care, relate to specific groups but form the basis of a decent society and now account for the majority of KCC's budget.

"We help and support vulnerable people of all ages and the decisions we take will have great impact on many people's lives. The authority believes that those services to the young, the elderly, the vulnerable and those with disabilities, are a true test of a successful Kent community and that residents have a firm understanding that they must be properly funded." He

said it had been widely reported that several other county councils had found themselves in deep financial crises and had been forced to cut essential services, but Kent had so far avoided that. "In the past few years we have had to take many common-sense decisions, transform the way we work and manage every service we deliver wisely. In some areas identified by residents as the most important to them, we have even managed to increase investment and spending. There is, however, no doubt that we face some tough decisions. Councils have been given a flat settlement until at least 2020 which includes extra money from modest annual council tax increases. That means the cash we have to spend on services has not kept pace with costs and demands for those services which have been rising for a number of years.

"We have some big decisions to make and we would very much value resident's views and suggestions before we make them."

**KCC is inviting views on three key areas.**

- Council Tax – is a rise acceptable if it helps to sustain the services you most value?
- The future of our services – are we focussing on the right priorities or have we got some things wrong?
- How can we improve our communication with you – so that you are aware of the **challenges we face now and in the future?**

The council estimates that increased demands and costs will amount to about £66million, which together with net grant reductions of £28million result in the need to raise and/or save £94million. Increasing council tax by just under 3% plus the 2% social care levy would raise £37million, and the remainder must be found from making savings and already planned but limited use of reserves. At this stage the council is still to identify detailed plans for around £16million pending the Chancellor's budget and local government settlement.

Taken together, the proposed changes would add just over £1 per week to the KCC element of the council tax bill for a typical Band C property.

KCC has already saved around £640million over the last eight years. In doing so it has sought to protect 'front line' services but that means reductions have fallen more heavily on other areas. It has achieved about a third of its savings by providing the same service for less money and another third by doing things differently.

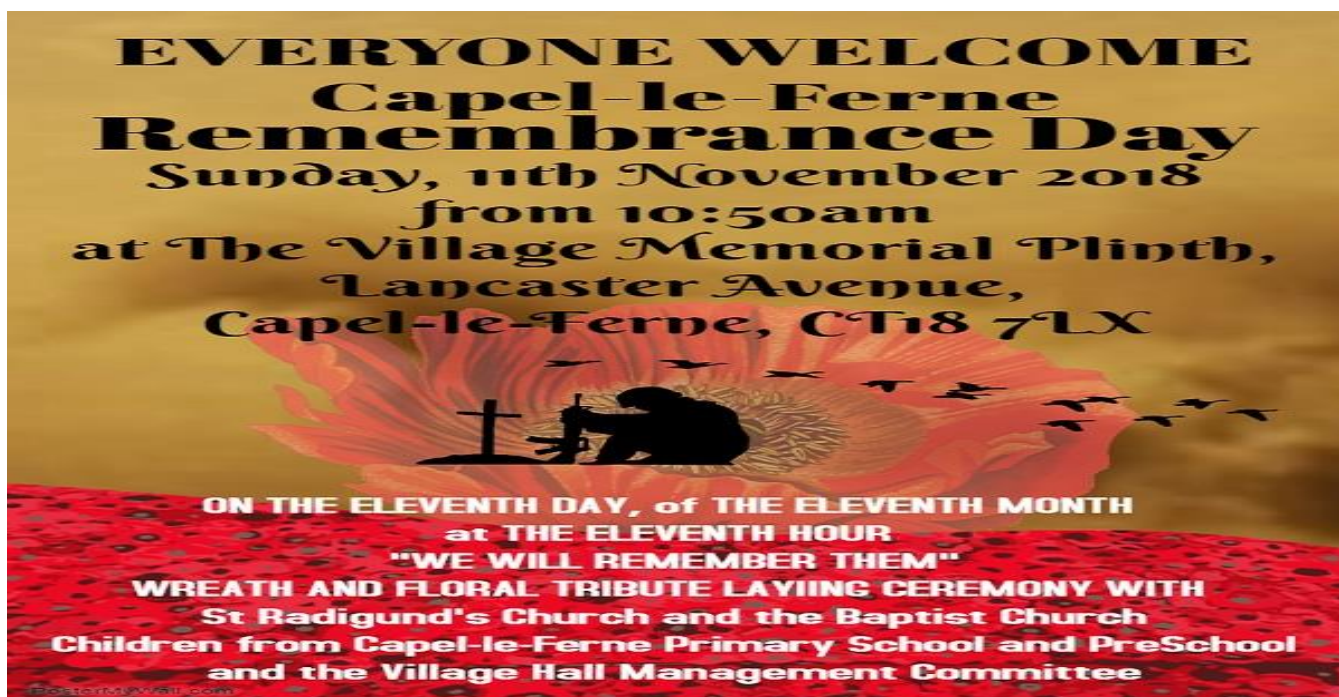

Hello Everyone, We had a busy evening at the October meeting, starting with a very interesting talk from one of our old members Kath Clark who moved to Capel as a young child with her family. Kath's Father was a bricklayer and had a lot of work on the Cliffs Estate as it was then called, she has a very good memory of her life at the old school and about some of the shops in the village that were inside the front room of some people's houses. Kath told us that the village was mainly farms and very few houses with no drainage or lighting and very bad roads, but they had deliveries of milk, meat and coal and lots of shops and garages, including hairdressers, fish shop, wool and haberdashery shop, sweet shops, post office, butchers shop with the slaughter house behind it and a Co-op. There was an old shed like building that was the old village hall until the new one was eventually finished in 1946. One memory was when one Sunday the soldiers came to St Marys Church and two battalions arrived at once by accident leaving everyone really squashed together and crammed in. Kath could remember some of the houses that are still there and who used to live in them. She seems to have had a very interesting life growing up in the village.

After giving out all the birthday cards, we had an update on the upcoming events such as asking for help to make cakes for the cake stall at the craft fair on the 10<sup>th</sup> of November and some of the plans for the next few months going up right into next year.

Having had a good look at the competition entries and choosing what we thought were the most interesting items we made our way to the refreshments and chatted to different members catching up on news.

Once back in and seated, Glynis gave a brief talk about the food bank The Trussell Trust, to enlighten us on the history and how it helps people when in need. We were told that a couple called Carol and Paddy Henderson founded The Trussell Trust in 1997, based on a legacy left by Carol's mum Betty Trussell; initially they were helping poor children in Bulgaria. In 2000 a mother in Salisbury called them and said my children are hungry and I need help. After investigating data on poverty they started the Salisbury Food Bank in their shed and garage providing 3 days of emergency food to people in crisis. There are now 420 Foodbanks and 1,200 distribution centres. Many things are needed, dried food, tins, and toiletries, cleaning products, pet food and donations. Supermarkets are very generous with giving products. Vouchers are received after an interview and having referrals from schools, citizens advice, probations and the like. Many people when entering are very emotional some at the relief of getting help and tell the story of why they are there, some may be embarrassed but are quickly put at ease with the friendly, caring staff. A lot of the people coming to the foodbank are there because of Universal Credit, being made redundant, or working but getting a low income and have a high rent, so many different crisis's.

Eve won the monthly competition with a framed Capel map. We then had the raffle.

As we move into Autumn much of our local wildlife is searching for safe places to shelter for Winter. Unfortunately, this often means a nice enticing pile of leaves and branches that are waiting for Bonfire Night. Each year countless numbers of hedgehogs, amphibians such as frogs, newts and toads, and mice suffer terribly or die from their burns.

If you are having or attending a bonfire celebration this year, or just clearing up garden rubbish, please spare some time to quickly check to see if any wildlife is sheltering before you set light - lift up the base and listen for any noises, looking carefully with a torch, even better move the bonfire completely before lighting, and light from one side only. Of course, if you let your waste sit naturally in a quiet corner of your garden you may give a home to a hibernating hedgehog who will return in the Spring to eat your slugs and snails - the best pest control is a nature!

After the hot summer the wildlife of Capel needs all the help it can get, so a few minutes of your time may save a mum and baby hedgehogs who call your garden home.

We are befriending several villagers who live on their own, popping in to see them regularly. Recently we have helped one couple, by taking the husband to hospital for surgery and bringing him home afterwards. We have a volunteer who in the summer has been visiting with flowers from her garden.

We have also done some admin tasks, arranged hearing aid repairs, contacted the council re bin collection from inside the gate and arranged an emergency plumber. Our coffee mornings on the first Friday in the month are well attended and proving very popular. We plan to host a Christmas lunch in December.
