From the Vicarage

There must something about coffee. My father lived alone in later life. When I rang to ask how he was, he nearly always told me that he had taken the bus into town, been shopping, and had coffee. He never missed having coffee.

He had become quite deaf, and would avoid family and other social gatherings rather than face the embarrassment of not being able to follow conversation. But I've never forgotten going with him to the café where he used to have coffee – and for the first time in years seeing him smiling and chatting with people who had become his friends, and who naturally raised their voices to include him in their conversation without giving it a second thought.

In the parish where I was a curate, a young man started coming to church whose life had been difficult. One morning after the service he asked if we could meet for coffee and a chat. Sadly, it never happened. Tragically and unexpectedly, he died a couple of weeks later. I remarked to someone that the promised coffee and chat would have to wait for heaven. "Don't worry," he replied, "he'll have a coffee waiting for you when you get there."

I was reminded of all this by the twice-monthly Friday coffee mornings that we have started holding at St Radigund's in Capel, and the joy of seeing people coming together, chatting, smiling and making friends. Yes, there is definitely something about coffee.

I don't know whether they have coffee in heaven or not - but since Jesus once described the Kingdom of Heaven as being like someone giving a banquet, I wouldn't be at all surprised. There must be something there that goes with coming together, chatting, smiling and making friends... Brian

The demand for storage space the hall has been steadily increasing. As part of the drive to provide more storage space the use of the chairs hired out from the hall has been reviewed. In view of the low demand for them it has been decided to dispose of them (passing them on to Operation Sunshine for use in an African School). The committee apologies for any inconvenience this may cause but believe it is more important to provide storage space for those who hire the hall. It will still be possible to hire tables at £2.50 each.

It seems to have been a very busy year for the hall and it's hard to believe it is September already. The Garage Safari, so well supported by so many in the village, is only possible because of the number of volunteers who help, usually behind the scenes. Thank you one and all, especially the new kitchen team. Fingers crossed they will be happy to help again next year. The village hall committee would also like to thank the Parish Council for allowing the use of Jubilee Field as a car park. It is well publicised as the place to park.

The new front of the building should be finished by now (the editor's tight deadline means that while writing this the builders are still hard at work). Although the builders were recommended by the architects, the work was put out to competitive tender. Of the three companies who responded, Complete Builders, submitted the preferred bid. Their catch phrase of 'we only have solutions' has proven to be true; as with all projects there have been one or two hiccups which were resolved without stress. Despite the weather the project has run to time, partly thanks to their willingness to work late –the brickies worked until nearly 8.00pm one Friday night!

A huge thank you to everyone for their patience during the work and we hope you agree it makes access to the hall for those with mobility difficulties much easier as well as fitting in well with the rest of the hall. Part of the brief to the architect was to make the hall look more welcoming, which we hope you agree is achieved to some extent. The permanent flooring will be laid later this year once the screed has had time to thoroughly dry out.

The hall is slowly being tidied and the intention is to move the books and coat rails into the lobby, giving more space and a cleaner look in the hall. There is also an increasing demand for storage and various options, including some in use at other halls, are being explored. Now the building work is completed we are ready to accept more books, paperbacks for preference. The Pilgrim's Hospice bookshop is happy to accept text books and hardback.

September is the end of the financial year for the hall. Early October the books will be sent to the auditor for scrutiny and returned to us just in time for the Annual Meeting at the end of November. The date and time will be published nearer the time and Trustees will be available to answer your questions – please don't make them too hard. It's also time to elect the new Trustees; anyone living in the 'area of benefit' is eligible to stand. If you are (or know someone who might be) interested, please talk to one of the current Trustees – their details are in the back of Grapevine (page 15). There's an immense satisfaction putting something back into our community and all sorts of talents, skills and experience are needed. Commitment can be as little as a few hours once a month upwards. Alternatively, there is always a need for volunteers to help on an ad hoc basis. It's a great way to get to know people in the village, especially if you have recently moved into Capel-le-Ferne.

Clubs and organisations are back from their summer break and by now should have made arrangements to collect the new keys from the Village Hall during the Garage Safari on 3rd September. If the current key holder is holding their own sale that day, could they please arrange an alternative member to bring ALL hall keys to exchange. The lock to the small hall is also being changed so the only keys anyone will need to retain are those to storage cupboards/lockers.

Since Post Office Limited closed the village post office in 2007 Rachel Chandler has helped run a postal service for local residents, providing stamps and accepting parcels at the weekly Farmers' Market. This has proved very popular with residents and over the years Rachel has got to know many of them well. We need to congratulate Rachel on being appointed as a management accountant to a firm in Ashford. She will be greatly missed by the stall holders and customers at the weekly Market. It does offer an opportunity for someone who would like to be involved in the market and to give a bit to the community. We would appreciate one or two (dare we ask for three?) volunteers to help keep this service running? For more information contact Cherry on 255114 or Sally on 07730475838.

The Farmers' Market continued throughout the summer, despite the building works. The temporary entrance at the side encouraged many people to spend a bit of time (and money) at the craft market that runs alongside the Farmers' Market. It's there every week and the range of items varies. Regular visitors may have noticed a few of the changes which have taken place over the summer. Barbara has decided to retire and intends to honour the orders she has taken for Christmas cakes. Please talk to Debbie the meat who will take messages, letting Barbara know if anyone wants to cancel their order. Once we know who has ordered we will make special arrangements for the cakes to be delivered to the market ready for collection.

Sarah, from the Flour Jar, now alternates with Sprinkles, offering arrange of sweet treats and chutneys. The Flour Jar is a micro bakery based in Hawkinge. In addition to the cakes and delicacies Sarah brings to the market she is happy to take orders. You may like to add a tasty preserve to your order, including marmalades, jams, jellies, relishes and chutneys. Varieties depend on the season and what is available as the ingredients are locally sourced where possible, some are even home grown. If you have any specific requirements or allergies please ensure you let her know. Nuts are used in certain products but can be omitted if necessary. Items need to be collected or, depending on the size of the order, can be delivered within a 5 mile radius of Hawkinge. Do you live further away? Get in touch as she can deliver with a per mileage delivery charge. Jams and chutneys can be packaged in gift boxes or packed with scones for an afternoon treat. The entrance to the side door has been lined by Kevin with his soft fruits, apples and pears and, on alternate weeks the nursery and wood man, both with a wonderful range of items. Low Wood Nursery is manned by Andrew and Mary (they say they and their brothers and sisters all have religious names). Their plants are beautiful and Andrew and Mary are so knowledgeable about each in terms of best locations, soils and how high/wide they will grow. If they haven't brought what you are looking for talk to them and they will endeavour to bring it to their next visit. Inside the hall, Mick has his plants ready for sale at his usual prices - and they grow so well in local gardens. As the summer draws to a close his stock is dwindling so grab a bargain before they're gone. The woodman alternates with Low Wood nursery. The range of wooden items has been selected to be practical and reasonably priced. I love the twirling spirals for the garden and the crumb catching bread board is great for keeping the kitchen tidy. Once you've used one you'll never go back to an ordinary bread board again.

Sue and Doug took a short break during the summer – they are dependent on how many fish are locally available for catching. We will bring you news of their return as soon as we hear local stocks have increased enough for local fishing to recommence.

Our 'faithful' stall holders continue to bring their goodies every week. Meat and dairy, bread and pies, smoked salmon and taramasalata, fruit and vegetables, eggs. Most of the produce is grown in Kent with care. I recently visited a farm where the chickens, destined for a national chain, had been rescued from a barn. To my horror they had no feathers. The meat on sale at the farmers' market has a much more ethical background and hormones are not used routinely to 'beef it up' if you'll forgive the pun! Whatever is sold at the market you can challenge any of our stall holders about the welfare of their animals, what chemicals are used (organic principles are followed) and what preserves are used. There is a saying 'you are what you eat'; the market offers an opportunity to eat food produced with care and ethics. We look forward to seeing you every Tuesday.



Summary of some items discussed at meetings on Tuesday, 15th August 2017




• Requests from public to address the Council, plus Surgery and Other Feedback: Small development of retirement homes presented by resident to members at meeting. Request to write to District Council to postpone items concerning developments in Capel from their next Planning Committee meeting and to send in further response with application history. Blocked footpath on A20 reported to KCC Public Rights of Way. Concerns on white van cruising village reported to Community Warden to monitor. Temporary 40mph sign adjacent to Helena Road (Dover bound) relocated. • Traffic Management: Some works still ongoing on A20 to install permanent signage for TAP. Councillors to address the need for a further meeting with MP in October and endeavour to obtain more up to date traffic figures from Police. Relocation of 40/30 mph signage on New and Old Dover Road to be addressed by requesting a meeting with MP. Accident record list revamped for further additions. • Planning: Land South of New Dover Road - waiting Management Plan for meadow area as part of the conditions of development. Land North of New Dover Road and Land between 107-127 Capel Street – being presented to District Council Planning Committee for consideration on Thursday, 24th August. Form to be completed for member of Parish Council to speak at the DDC meeting. Letter to be sent to DDC to request a deferment until their September meeting, due to holiday period and to respond to historical further applications information received. **DDC Review of Local Plan**: Response to this ongoing, with the members processing a questionnaire to deliver to residents for their views. • Neighbourhood Watch: White flower boxes noted on a need to monitor for planting. Play Equipment Status: Annual RoSPA Inspection completed and contents noted. Zip-wire tyre to be investigate for cost of replacement. Tri-picnic benches to be commercially cleaned. • Highways: No report. • Public Rights of Way: Meeting held with North Downs Way Trail Manager and several items noted. Earth deposited on clifftop to be noted and report to District Environment Officer for further advice. • Other: Change in Parish Boundary to be reviewed, map presented to Commission for consideration. Bus shelter missing panes reported for replacement. Parish Council banner and cloth to be purchased for Surgery and other presentations. Condition of phones boxes to be reported.

Next Parish Council meeting is on Tuesday, 19th September 2017 at 7.30pm in the Village Hall (Small Hall).







Energy Deal is a free to join scheme, which gives residents the chance to make savings on their energy bills by registering to take part. A one day reverse auction will then be held on 10 October, where suppliers compete with their best offers. The winning suppliers send registrants their personalised offer for consideration. There is no obligation to switch. Sign up and see if you can save. In 2016, the total sum of savings for Dover District residents was £47,351.32. Figures after the recent May auction showed Dual Fuel customers who registered/ switched could save an average of over £150 on their annual energy bills. A recent survey, undertaken by the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy shows that 48% of respondents have never switched, and only 17% had switched in the last year. Customers on a fixed tariff are urged to check their fixed tariff end date, as once this ends they will be moved to a standard tariff. If your fixed deal is coming to an end shortly, you will usually be able to switch without penalty during the last 42-49 days of a fixed tariff, check with your supplier as this varies.
