From the Vicarage

A couple came to see me about being married in one of our churches recently. One of them used to live in the area, and so they had come to me – but that was partly because when they had first telephoned their local parish the person taking the call had come across as abrupt, and they hadn't wanted to go back to them.

I was surprised, because I know the person in question to be a warm, friendly soul who would do anything for anybody – but we all know how it is when the phone rings just as dinner is ready, or when we have just got out of the shower. I made a mental note to be more conscious of how I answer the phone – it just goes to show how first impressions count.

I have had to remember this myself when answering the phone during the past week. Colds make me grumpy, and things that don't usually bother me become irritating. It began last weekend with a tickle at the back of the throat and by midweek I was already onto my second box of tissues.

During my student days I attended a church in London. In those days large parishes often had a vicar and two curates, and there they were all single and shared a vicarage with a housekeeper, rather like TV's *Father Ted* - except that this housekeeper, unlike the cheery Mrs Doyle, was a retired hospital matron who meant well but could nevertheless reduce anyone who rang the vicarage doorbell to jelly in seconds. I once mentioned in front of her that colds make me grumpy. "That's because you're a man!" she thundered. "Men think it's beneath their dignity to have colds!"

Jesus once went to dinner with friends. While Mary sat listening to Jesus, her sister Martha was preparing dinner, fretting about all she had to do – until she finally lost patience and complained. "You are worried and distracted by many things," Jesus replied. "There is need of only one thing."

Martha reminds me of myself with a cold. If she did have one it might explain why she was fretting, and why Jesus had to remind her – and us – not to worry about the little things in life that don't matter as much as we might think they do.



More ways to contact your neighbourhood police officer

As part of a new initiative, Police Contact Points have been launched in the east of the county in July, and will come to West Kent in August, and North Kent in September. Police Contact Points are held each day from Wednesday through to Sunday, mainly in rural locations, on a rolling two-week schedule. Our police vans stop at a prominent location for one and a half hours per visit, enabling residents to drop by and speak to a neighbourhood officer about any policing concerns or issues they may have. The new Contact Points are in addition to the existing surgeries, meetings and online question and answer sessions local officers hold each month. The contact points are currently available in Ashford, Canterbury, Dover, Shepway and Thanet and by the autumn will be available across the county. Residents can follow their progress on dedicated Twitter accounts. Kent County Council is currently reviewing the way in which our Children's Centres operate. We have put together a proposal for how Kent's Children's Centres can work sustainably in the future, and want to know what you think. A consultation on this proposal will be taking place between 4th July and 4th October 2013. Our priorities are to continue to deliver universal frontline services across the County, to provide targeted provision to those children and their families who need it most, and to do this within the resources available. Significant savings of £1.5 million are needed because of a reduction in public funding. The proposal we have put together sets out how the available money can be focused more on actual services for children and their families, and less on running buildings and other overhead costs. It does this while maintaining the overall accessibility of services and support for those with the most need. We are consulting on one proposal which includes; 1. Reducing the number of Children's Centres. 2. Linking Children's Centres to reduce management and administrative costs. 3. Reducing hours at some Children's Centres. If you want to contribute to the consultation, which we hope you do, please go to www.kent.gov.uk/childrenscentres, and read the document we have put together. There is also a survey where you can tell us what you think, which is really important in shaping the future of Children's Centres in Kent. A sensible approach to street lighting

Kent County Council has launched a public consultation on the hours it is proposing to switch-off lights during the early morning as part of a drive to deliver better value for money for council taxpayers.

It proposes to convert around 70,000 of its 120,000 street lights to 'partnight' lighting. This could involve switching these lights off between midnight and 5:30a.m. The county council will not switch off any street lights in town centres, areas with CCTV, antisocial behaviour areas, at busy road junctions, roundabouts or sites with road safety issues. Residents, businesses, motorists and other groups are being asked for their views on the hours of proposed part-night lighting, and the criteria for selecting lights to be part of this programme. This approach will help the council meet the challenge of rising energy costs, carbon emissions and light pollution. Kent County Council Cabinet Member for Transport and Environment, David Brazier, said: We are taking a safe and sensible approach to rationalising our street lights. We want to ensure we make the best use of Kent's tax payer's money. We propose switching off lights when they don't need to be lit. This is the most effective way of saving energy, very much like a householder turning off lights at night when going to bed. "Rising electricity costs are a reality and will continue to go up year on year. Next year we face a bill of £6.4million for illuminating street lights and the associated carbon tax. A considerable amount is spent on lighting streets in the early hours and we believe we can save around 20% - that's more than £1million by turning lights off when they don't need to be lit. These proposals would save 5,000 tonnes of carbon emissions. "We want to hear from people so they can help inform the way forward with our approach to street lighting." To take part in the consultation or find out more information, please visit: www.kent.gov.uk/streetlights.

The County Council has already discussed its proposals with Kent Police; the Kent Association of Local Councils; and all 12 Joint Transportation Boards, where local councillors discuss transport issues. Meanwhile, later this summer, Kent County Council will turn off around 3,000 surplus lights on a trial basis. These are lights that are nolonger necessary and would not have been installed under current regulations. If safety or crime levels are adversely affected during the trial, the lights in question will be switched back on. The consultation will run until Friday 23 August. 
As usual our ladies have a busy month ahead of them - Darts, Craft, Scrabble, Home Economics, Book-Share etc.

THE PARISH COUNCIL DO NOT SUPPORT THE PRINCIPLE OF DEVELOPMENT ON THESE TWO SITES

(1) - between Capel Street and Cauldham Lane and (2) - opposite Battle of Britain Memorial site, New Dover Road.

At the July Parish Council meeting, members received a presentation from Quinn Estates about the concept of building some houses in Capel. The public had been invited to listen to the presentation at the same time as the Council.

During the business of the meeting, the Councillors, made the decision to enquire further from Quinn Estates and that of the Landowner, what their future intentions are now in relation to the potential proposals following their presentation. Therefore, the Parish Council view is to initially ascertain this intention from Quinn Estates and the Landowner and then act accordingly. This may be by way of organising an Exhibition at a future date, if they wish to continue with their proposal.

Furthermore, as requested by some residents, consideration was also given on providing all residents with guidelines and advice on the Planning Procedures, including relative roles of Parish and District Councils and items that could be considered if a Planning Application is deposited with Dover District Council, which may be used or addressed if objecting to any application. This will be published in Grapevine when completed.

However, following the meeting on July 16th the Parish Council contacted Quinn Estates and invited them to hold an exhibition and received a "declined" reply stating "they need to assess how they progress based upon feedback from the Parish Council and Dover District Council but until then a public exhibition is not suitable".
