



Christmas wishes do come true – the Sport England Inspired Facilities grant for £49,735 was approved, together with £9,250 from QE II Fields in Trust, and a further £2,500 Neighbourhood Forum grant! The total now stands at £81,344 - the Parish Council and its sub-group are making plans to start installing the recreational facilities within the next few months.

You will see below a revised plan to illustrate the location of the outdoor gym, mini skate park, zip wire and petanque area. Planning permission has been granted and work is being carried out to ensure that the best suited equipment is chosen.

Many people have been working very hard to ensure that this project is successful and we are sure you would like to join us in saying a BIG THANK YOU!

Even though a lot of money has been raised, there is still a long way to go and the project team are still beavering away to try and secure further funds.



News from the Battle of Britain Memorial Trust

Custodians of the National Memorial to the Few, Capel-le-Ferne, Kent

Help us make 2013 the year The Wing takes flight and is a particularly great year for those of us who want to keep alive the story of the Battle of Britain.

As we make resolutions to lose weight, keep fit, stop smoking or be less grumpy in the mornings, the Trust is getting ready to begin work on its new visitor centre at the National Memorial to the Few at Capel-le-Ferne in Kent. The Trust and its supporters have been working hard to raise the £2.8m needed to build and fit out The Wing, an exciting multi-media visitor experience that will attempt to bring to life the story of the Battle of Britain using video walls, special effects and hands-on exhibits – and 2013 is the year work is due to begin. This will not be a museum but an audio-visual experience that will highlight the heroism and the sacrifice behind the names on the Christopher Foxley-Norris Memorial Wall that stands just yards from where the new experience will be built. Folkestone surveyors Godden Allen Lawn came up with the stunning design for the building, which is based on the shape of R J Mitchell's iconic Spitfire wing, and local contractors will be invited to tender for the work. The site on the White Cliffs between Folkestone and Dover has been cleared, and archaeological investigations have been carried out to check that there is nothing significant that could delay the project. "We have the planning permission, we have the site and we have the commitment to build this much-needed visitor and Education Centre," explained Trust Chairman Richard Hunting CBE. "Our plan is to start work this spring so that we can have The Wing finished and fitted out towards the end of 2014. We will then schedule the official opening in July 2015, during the 75th anniversary of the Battle of Britain, when some of our veterans will take a well-deserved Centre stage. The funeral of William, who at 99 was thought to have been the oldest surviving Battle of Britain veteran, took place at St Clement Danes in London and was very well attended. The publicity surrounding his sad passing renewed the interest in the collection of William's poems published in 2011 in aid of the Wing Appeal and more than 200 copies have been sold in the past few weeks. William signed many of the books because he was determined to help raise as much money for the appeal as possible. If you still haven't ordered your copy of William's book, why not do so now? 



