#### <u>From the Vicarage</u>

We plough the fields with tractors, we sang. (Yes, slightly different words to the original hymn, I know). Seeds had been sown, and as quaint or as superstitious as it may seem to some, we prayed, as the Church has for centuries on Rogation Sunday, for farmers and for the harvest. Pests, disease and bad weather - much can go wrong, even in our modern world.

The anniversary of D Day was tinged with sadness for the congregation of St Radigund's as we prepared to say goodbye to a friend of ours. As a young merchant seaman he had been there, sowing with others of his generation the seeds of the freedoms we have enjoyed since.

Few of us now make a living from the land - but perhaps we sow seeds in other ways. A while ago, I was asked to work at a school some distance away. It involved an early start, a long drive, and some difficult classes. I was asked to teach Maths. I'm definitely no mathematician but I did my best, and in the class I taught about half settled to work, while others sat sullenly or chatted among themselves.

Not great, but a few days later the phone rang. Would I go back there and teach Maths until a new teacher arrived? I'm no mathematician, I replied – but they pleaded. So I survived by learning the night before what I had to teach the next day and muddled through until, to my relief, the new teacher arrived.

I was at that school again recently, for the first time in about a year. Passing some vaguely familiar faces in the corridor, I heard a voice behind me. Hey, Sir - I PASSED MY MATHS!

I smiled and gave him a thumbs-up sign. Harvest had arrived. Sown any good seeds lately? Brían

Saddle up for Air Ambulance bike ride - Life-saving charity Kent, Surrey & Sussex Air Ambulance is appealing for cyclists to sign up for this year's Double 100 Cycle Challenge and help save lives at night. The 100-mile or 100km bike ride is to be held on Sunday, September 28<sup>th</sup>, to mark the first anniversary of the launch of the night flying service. Last year's annual event raised more than £12,000 and organisers are aiming to double its success this year with two starting points at the helicopter bases at Marden and Redhill. The charity now has to raise an extra £1million a year to fund the cost of a 24-hour service, up from £5million to £6million. The ride is open to regular and occasional cyclists including individuals and teams with feeding stations along the scenic route. The first 200 riders to sign up will receive a special Air Ambulance jersey.







Kent Police has arrested and bailed a 49 year old woman from Folkestone following a report of a distraction burglary in Clifton Crescent, Folkestone, on Monday 26 May. It was reported that a woman knocked on the door of a flat at around 2pm and asked for a ball that had gone into the occupant's garden. The door was closed, but not locked, whilst the occupant checked her garden and as she was searching for the ball she heard a man's voice although she didn't see him. When she couldn't find any trace of the ball she returned to the flat. The woman had gone and the victim noticed that a camera was missing. In another similar incident reported to police, on Sunday 25 May between 4.40pm and 5pm, a man and a woman rang the elderly victim's doorbell and claimed that their dog had chased its ball into his rear garden. They allegedly invited themselves into the house in St. Michael's Street, Folkestone, and the man waited in the lounge whilst the victim and the woman checked the garden. The elderly man didn't see a dog and didn't find a ball. After the couple left, the victim discovered that his wallet and a purse were missing from his jacket. The male suspect is described as being in his late 20s to mid-30s, of skinny build, about 5 feet 8 inches tall and with short fair hair. He was wearing a top and jeans. His female accomplice had blonde hair and was wearing it in a ponytail. She is described as being of a similar age, height and build, as the man and was wearing a denim jacket. A third incident was reported to police on Monday 26 May in St Leonard's Road, Hythe. The victim is a partially blind and deaf man. In this case, a woman rang the doorbell and asked to use the telephone to call her mother to collect her. The victim invited the woman inside, leaving the front door open, and then a man appeared. He asked to use the toilet and then requested some sugar for his diabetic wife. Whilst the owner was on the phone to a neighbour the couple disappeared. It's believed nothing was taken although drawers and cupboards throughout the house were found open and ajar, when previously they had been closed. The reports to police have prompted District Commander for Shepway, Chief Inspector Darren Mullins, to issue a warning to people to be on their guard, particularly if they live alone. "Distraction burglars usually target vulnerable people like the elderly or infirm and try to gain entry to their victims' homes on the pretence of needing help. They play on their victims' goodwill and sense of sympathy which makes this an especially distressing crime for victims."

"It is not known at this stage if the three incidents are linked but I would urge people to be extra vigilant and take the simple but effective advice that is available on our website." Parish Councillor, Keith Pilcher, will be monitoring all equipment on the Field on a regular basis - but if you see anything that needs repair and/or adjustment, please contact the Parish Clerk. As previously mentioned, Councillors are extremely thankful that Lynn Brisley undertook this mammoth task and thanks were also expressed to the other members of the Project Sub-committee, (Cherry Leppard, Maureen Leppard, Keith Pilcher, James Sheridan and Jayne Stone, together with District/Ward Councillor Frederick Scales) and other members of the village who helped in anyway - and "last but not least", we cannot forget Capel Groundworks for the installation of pathways etc. Throughout the past two and half years they all laboured to provide our wonderful village with an extensive range of first class equipment for all to ... ENJOY!!!!!! ENJOY!!!!!! ENJOY!!!!!!
- Equipment status No items reported for repair. Trees causing obstruction within the field vicinity are to be cut back and/or removed. Continuation to investigate replacement of some equipment in the junior play area is on-going. Signs to be erected on junior equipment site, that the equipment in that area are for the intended use of "Under 12 year olds", the Multi Use Games Area, Gym, Mini Skate-Park and Zip-Wire are for all ages! • Land Allocation Local Plan – Nothing further reported, main modifications to plan have started, but do not affect Capel. Further information from Government Inspector is anticipated in early August. It is understood that it is likely, there will be no more consultation for Capel. • Anaerobic Digester Plant PlanningApplication – Permission has been granted by Dover District Council with 14 conditions. St Mary's Churchyard Maintenance - At time of meeting, the Councillors were awaiting reply from the Parochial Church Council on several questions on this issue. • Crime Reports – 3 Fly tipping incidents, 2 Neighbourhood disputes and selling of cars in lay-by/top of Capel Street reported to the meeting and dealt with. Trial bikes being used on roads/public rights of way, also reported and subject to on-going investigation by the Police. • Highways – Illegal advertisement signs that have appeared were reported and being dealt with by Dover District Council. • Other – Donations agreed to Air Ambulance of £100 and RNLI of £25.

What are the Objectives of Speed Watch?

• To increase the awareness of speeding and thereby reduce it.

 To improve the safety of our roads.
 To better the quality of life in our communities. How Does Speed Watch Work

Operating at carefully selected roadside sites in 30 and 40-miles per hour (mph) speed limits, a group, typically of three CSW practitioners, monitors the speed of passing vehicles using a portable speed indication device such as that pictured above.

They record and report the speed and identifying details of vehicles travelling at or above nationally specified thresholds (35 and 46 mph). The registered keepers of vehicles observed repeatedly or excessively (limit plus 50%) speeding anywhere in Kent in the previous 12 months are then sent warning letters and speed awareness advice by Kent Police.



We all had a great day and it all helps to promote local produce, which certainly provides better quality, flavour and freshness.

Another new stall will be joining us soon, Handmade by Hannah, producing Mains & Puds, great for those days when you don't feel like cooking, but want a home cooked meal! Real Deal Roasters (freshly ground coffee), and R & R Ales will be attending once a month now as they are becoming so busy, which is great for them but a shame for us. 
