



Hope everyone had a good month and enjoyed the sunshine and warmth that it came with it.



Summary of some items discussed at meetings on Tuesday, 19th April 2016



Annual Parish Meeting held before business was discussed – Chairman's Report for 2015-2016 was read and is on Page 10.

There was no further comments and the next Annual Parish Meeting was agreed as Tuesday, 18th April 2017.

• Request from the public to address the Council: None. Surgery Feedback: Several comments were received on parts of the village, especially Cauldham Lane and Satmar area showing signs of inconsiderate discarding of Litter. Councillors made the decision to hold a litter picking event, on Saturday, 21st May @ 2pm. See details below. • Neighbourhood Watch: Thanks were expressed to organisers for the Information Day held on 16th April and to everyone who attended. Andrew, our Community Warden, will be endeavouring to; Rejuvenate street co-ordinators, Address parking problems and blocking pavements in Capel Street/Lancaster Avenue etc., dealing with fly-tipping in vicinity, monitoring suspicious vans/lorries in village, cold-callers, reinstating the Speed-Watch Scheme and patrolling the B2011 in Hi-viz jacket to slow down traffic. • Equipment status report: The swings at Playing Field now have new chains and fitments. • Highways and Public Rights of Way: Drainage issues in various locations to be reported to Kent Highways to request ditches and grips to be dug out and cleaned.

• <u>Planning:</u> <u>Development of Land South of New Dover Road</u>: <u>"STOP PRESS"</u>

This Application was discussed by Dover District Council Planning Committee on, Thursday, 21st April 2016 and the Committee decided to REFUSE the application. See below report.

• <u>Other</u>: Bus Shelter outside Battle of Britain Memorial Site waiting new roof and re-positioning. White flower box/gates to be refurbished by Councillors. 1,000 Daffodil bulbs on order for planting in September along the Lancaster Avenue side of the Jubilee Playing Field to commemorate HM Queen's 90th Birthday. Help required for Event Day on Saturday, 23rd July. One application was received to fill the Vacancy on the Parish Council - following a ballot by Councillors, Mr Gordon Holliday was co-opted as a member.

In the case of a major emergency the Parish Council would endeavour to co-ordinate community efforts until the 999 services are able to reach the village. To enable the Parish Council to respond effectively, it would be useful to know what skills and assets are available in the village - it would therefore be appreciated if you would spend a few minutes completing the enclosed inset form and return it to the Parish Clerk. Thank-you.






