

It's true! St Anthony's Church in Alkham really is haunted! As we had coffee after the service a few Sundays ago, two younger members of our congregation excitedly produced an i-Pad which clearly showed a picture of me standing in the church with a spook looking over my shoulder. Moments later, the same i-Pad revealed that the churchyard was full of them! You couldn't see any of them without an i-Pad of course.

Download something called Pokémon Go onto a smartphone and the screen reveals a map of your surrounding area. It may show a brightly coloured monster or Pokémon nearby for you to catch and train – a Pikachu, perhaps, or a Jigglypuff. Use it to fight other Pokémon at a Pokémon gym – there are two in Capel (I think!) You can stock up with supplies at PokéStops like the one at St Radigund's Church Hall. Although the antics of some have led Cologne Cathedral to ban Pokémon Go ("the cathedral is not a playground"), other churches have connected with their PokéStop status by offering squash, biscuits, phone chargers


Confused? Don't worry if you don't follow any of this. Ask any teenager with a smartphone. They will be able to explain it far better than I have... **Brian**

When the Farmers' Market was started the then organisers, Cherry, Gwyn, Jenny and Mick were told that it would never take off as a weekly event on Tuesdays. How wrong was that advice! Over 14 years later the market is still going strong – in fact a couple of weeks ago we had over 244 visitors.

Stall holders come to Capel-le-Ferne Farmers' Market for variety of reasons, some by invitation and others contact us and ask to come. Often it is a new producer wanting to test the market to find out if there is a demand for whatever the product is. We try to ensure a variety of products as well as making sure all the basics are there. The main hall focusses on the food items and the small hall is full of crafters and the community postal service.

Some stallholders, like Heather, have been with us from the beginning. Shirley's farm eggs are another 'founder stall'. Although Paul is no longer with us, Derek ensures eggs (many double yolkers) are available every week. Land's End nursery now attend in the guise of woollen knits. Shoppers and visitors to the market are now greeted with a beautiful display of plants from Summerfield Nursery. Usually opposite, but sometimes next to her, is Kevin with his van of fruit, all grown in Kent. Without doubt his soft fruits prove the sayings about local foods tasting better than food with many food miles on the clock.

The newest of our stallholders is Mike, with his produce straight from a farm. He is one of the rare examples where the organisers, in order to offer shoppers variety, accept produce from out of Kent. Mike's produce fits the spirit of the Farmers' Market. His produce is direct from an Italian Farm, the olives are free from colourings – look at the 'black' olives and ask him about them. People in other villages talk about his balsamic vinegar. Whilst you can just buy balsamic vinegar in the supermarket, Mike offers a variety, one is even best served on ice cream. If you try to buy his balsamic vinegar he'll ask what you want to use it for and recommend the most suitable.

Marsh produce now co-ordinate the stalls and help fill the gaps in the range. They now sell milk, butter and cheese as well as meat and game. Their sausages come highly recommended. Shopping there is easier because they accept cards. Much of PJs produce comes from local farms, but he gets up at a time of day I didn't know existed to go to Covent Garden to supplement his stock.

Cakes are usually made and sold by Barbara, currently recovering from surgery, so Gaynor has stepped in to ensure your sweet tooth is catered for. This is in addition to the ready meals she makes.

Savoury goodies can be found on Mike the Artisan's stall. A mix of meats, smoked & deli products, and baked items – try his new range of tortolas – (or is it tortillas?) - with a hint of spice? I usually buy my breakfast from his stall. Further up the Hall is Farthingloe Farm, who produce some items especially for the Market, including meat pies, cream slices and bakery foods.

When you come to see us pop into the small hall and look at their beautiful items, or just have a chat. And of course there's Ruby's refreshment 'stall. Plenty of reasons for you to visit



- Request from the public to address the Council, Surgery and Other Feedback: Thanks were expressed from a resident on the provision of the drop kerbs at road junctions along the New Dover Road, now making it easier to get through the village on a mobility scooter. Subsidence reported on highway, junction of Alexandra Road/Old Dover Road. Overgrown residential hedges and at gas sub-station reported. Neighbourhood Plan: Public Meeting arranged for 24<sup>th</sup> September (see separate insert on Page 9).
- Neighbourhood Watch: Investigations on-going on provision of "Life-lines" for residents and further information to follow on other resources for vulnerable residents. Equipment status report: New CCTV signs erected. Repairs to "Wetpour surface" in junior play area reported and contractor ordered to rectify. Highways and Public Rights of Way: 20mph Zone, B2011 and Capel Street speeding an on-going issue, with enforcement now being a problem, which the Councillors are endeavouring to address they are waiting a decision from Kent Police on a 50% grant to purchase a Speed Camera so that the Speedwatch Scheme in the village can be resurrected. Planning: (See insert below) Other: The Parish Council enquired with Mick Marshall on a "village celebration" to commemorate his BEM Award. Mick has requested that he would prefer a donation is made from the Parish Council towards providing a Water Well in Malawi which Pam Barr of the Baptist Church is fund-raising towards. #### ANNUAL PLAYING FIELD EVENT

For the last five years, Capel-le-Ferne Parish Council have been organising a Community Playing Field Event, which this year, despite the problems encountered with traffic issues, was a great day. #### "Village Commemoration" BEM Award for Mick Marshall

I first went to Africa about 9 years ago. On that visit I stayed in the guest house where our cook had malaria. I had never seen anyone with malaria before, he was so ill but had to keep working to feed his family. No sick pay in Uganda. When I came home I decided to raise money for mosquito nets. Now I am retired I make tote bags and sell them to raise money for nets. I have now been to Africa four times. On my last visit my friend and I worked at a centre for trafficked children, redecorating the bedrooms and the dining room. We stayed with the manager in his bungalow where we met Peter. Peter was trafficked as a 12 year old. Taken from his family in Malawi to work on a farm in Zambia. Thankfully someone recognised him as not "local" and reported the fact to the police. After contact between Police and Social Service and the Salvation Army, Peter was repatriated back to Malawi where he stayed in the Salvation Army's centre for trafficked children. Now aged 23 he has a dream. He wants to be a farmer. Lin and I spent time talking to Jimmy, the Centre manager, about Peter's dream; and we felt that we could help him realise that dream. Land in Malawi is cheap compared to England. £150 will buy an acre of land. For a viable small holding you would need 10 acres - £1,500 plus money to equip the farm and buy seeds etc. But a borehole to ensure that when the droughts come, as they inevitably do come in Malawi, the land could be irrigated would cost £3,250. More than the cost of the land! Thanks to so many generous people we have purchased the land, and sent Peter on a couple of placements to learn how to farm. Now we are raising funds for the borehole. Once Peter had been told by Jimmy what we were planning to do, his immediate response was "now I know there is a God, and I promise that I will always employ other trafficked young men on the farm, to help them get started in life, just as I have been". Once we have raised the money for the borehole - we are getting there - we want to help a girls' school in Blantyre to get water on site for a toilet block. There are 1300 girls in the school and only 2 toilets. I have two toilets in my

I am so grateful to Mick for suggesting that money, which the village would have used to give him a party, should come to Project Peter. This just reinforces what a wonderful man he is and so deserving of his honour.






