

### From the vicarage

I must admit that I do enjoy visiting cathedrals – especially ones that I haven't visited before. Visiting Gloucester not long after Christmas, I took the opportunity to have a proper look around the Cathedral.

I discovered that it contains the tomb of King Edward II. He became king when his father, Edward I, died while campaigning against the Scots in 1307. His father had been widely respected. Not so Edward, who seems to be remembered mainly for falling out with powerful barons, losing the Battle of Bannockburn to Robert the Bruce, and lavishing gifts on his favourites at court while neglecting his wife, Princess Isabella of France. She took her revenge when she returned from a diplomatic visit to her brother with not only her lover, a nobleman whom Edward had exiled, but also an army. Supported by several nobles who shared her low opinion of her husband, she deposed him in January 1327 and had their son, also Edward, crowned in his place.

A sign next to the once-magnificent tomb that Edward III had built for his father in the Cathedral tells visitors that Edward was imprisoned in Berkeley Castle and probably murdered there soon afterwards. It goes on: Edward's poor judgement lost him the confidence of his people and the throne. How can we help others find a way forward in life when everything seems to have gone wrong?

An interesting thought. We may not have thrones to lose, but I suspect that most of us can probably think of times when we've made mistakes too, and perhaps wish that we had done things differently. St Paul wrote in I Corinthians 13 that "Love keeps no score of wrongs." God, he reminds us, never gets tired of our new beginnings. ... Brian

Temporary Road Closure – Winehouse Lane, Capel-le-Ferne (Dover) – 2 March 2020 It will be necessary to close part of Winehouse Lane, Capel-le-Ferne, in the Dover area, planned from Monday 2 March 2020 for an estimated period of up to 1 week.

This is to undertake planned alterations to junction of Winehouse Lane and Old Dover Road.

Winehouse Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with Old Dover Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site. Local access to the remainder of Winehouse Lane continues from New Dover Road direction. The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2011 New Dover Road and Old Dover Road.

The closure is to enable Kent County Council to carry out essential junction modification works. Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours. There is a slight chance that the works may over-run for unforeseen reasons such as adverse weather conditions or




# St Radigund's Players Annual Pantomime 2020



### **CAPEL-LE-FERNE PARISH COUNCIL ACTION PLAN**

Following the Village Questionnaire circulated in 2018/2019, a working party of Councillors produced an Action Plan from results received. The first and main feedback was relating to Traffic Management, which is now an on-going item visited by members at every meeting.

A further item that has recently been investigated by Parish Councillors is **Local Economy** – **i.e.** 

- Approach the Broadband & Telephone providers to enquire on improvements.
- Locate the masts that provide the signals to the village.
- Contact the water company enquire into improvements to the water pressure.

With regard to Broadband, this is being escalated via our District Councillor Jamie Rose, to Kent County Council and Jamie would welcome you contacting him with your individual issues. Please inform him direct, so he can take forward your concerns:

He can then ensure that the Kent County Council coordinator, dealing with Broadband and Telephone providers for Kent, is addressed for Capel-le-Ferne residents.

Likewise, the Council contacted Affinity Water on the issue reported of low water pressure in some areas of the Village. The following replies were received;

- Initially we would advise our customers to check all stop taps are fully open, it may also be worth them having a look around outside for any visible signs of a leak on the supply pipe, this is the pipe running from the boundary into the property and is their responsibility, also if this the old lead main it may be furred up affecting the flow and pressure they receive, they may have to consider replacing it.
- Affinity Water is only responsible for the flow and pressure to the boundary of the property, the flow rate should be a minimum of 9 litres per minute here. The legal requirement of pressure we are obliged to supply with here is 0.7 bar, however most of our properties have in the region of 2.5 bar. To test the pressure you have coming into the property from the main you can fill a gallon container from the cold kitchen tap and time it. If this fills in 30 seconds you have 1.5 bar, 20 seconds and you have 2 ½ bar, any quicker and the bar will be higher.
- We would suggest if the pressure is below 1 bar or too low for their requirements, we would be happy to attend to investigate, but this would need to be via an appointment. The Technician would carry out a pressure and flow test at this time, there is no charge for this. We would require access to your internal stop tap which must be in good working order, this is necessary to be able to carry out the relevant checks.
- Our appointment times are mornings between the hours of 8am and 1pm and afternoons 1pm and 4pm. To book one if appropriate please ring our Contact Centre on 0345 357 2407 any of our Advisors would be happy to do this for you.
- I hope this information is useful to you. Please do not hesitate to contact us again if you wish to discuss further.

On further contact, the following additional advice was received;

- I would like to confirm we have no pressure issues in this area and have not received further reports of this.
- If there was a mains water pressure issue we would be aware as it would affect all properties in the area. There are many factors that can affect the water to individual properties, many properties are on a shared water supply with their neighbours, this can affect the pressure and flow, that would not be an Affinity Water issue, it would have been the decision of the developers to build the properties in this way not the water company. Due to changes in legislation this is no longer permitted, all properties built now have to have their own metered supply.
- Many properties still have an old lead supply pipe, this is the pipe that runs from the boundary and into the property and is the owners responsibility, this is likely to be only 15ml size and can sometimes be furred up, again affecting the flow and pressure to that property. There could be an internal plumbing issue at a property, there could be an underground leak on the supply pipe that hadn't yet become visible.
- For all of these reasons, this is why we have a process to follow if there was an issue at an individual property. If we were supplying below the regulated minimums to an area, we would certainly be aware and be inundated with reports as it would probably cause no waters as well as low pressures.

The Parish Council therefore urge anyone experiencing low water pressure in the Village to contact Affinity Water for individual investigation by booking an appointment for a Technician to carry out a pressure and flow test, there is no charge for this. They will require access to your internal stop tap which must be in good working order, this is necessary to be able to carry out the relevant checks.





### **Kent County Council reporting road defects**

Kent Highways crews are finding and fixing potholes caused by the extensive rain over the last few weeks.

As surveys of the condition of roads continue following Storm Ciara and Storm Dennis bringing further wind and rain.

Last weekend highways' officers from Kent County Council dealt with over 500 enquiries to clear trees and remove surface water flooding.

Additional staff are on standby to deal with any emergencies on the highway.

During recent weekends, there was a yellow wind warning in place from 10am on Saturday to 11.59pm on Sunday, with a yellow rain warning between noon on Saturday and 9pm on Sunday.

Kent's roads have been saturated due to heavy rainfall since November and this has made the network extremely vulnerable to potholes.

Highways crews have been scouring the county's 5,400 miles of road network ensuring dangerous potholes are filled immediately.

Potholes not considered to be dangerous are placed into a programme and will be filled in within 28 days.

KCC highway manager Kirstie Williams said:

"We prioritise potholes according to how unsafe they're making the road and so whilst not all potholes reported to us are a priority, we do aim to fix all that are identified".

"Dangerous faults that pose an immediate risk of causing an accident are fixed within two hours of being found or reported to us while hazardous faults which could deteriorate quickly to become dangerous are fixed within seven days".

"For emergency potholes we sometimes have to make an instant repair by quickly filling the hole to make the road safe but we schedule a full permanent repair to prevent potholes from forming in the future".

"We work hard to carry out the majority of our larger repairs during the summer when there is less rain, temperatures are more suitable for the materials we use and there is no salt present from winter gritting ensuring a longer lasting repair"

Kent County Council encourages residents that spot potholes to report them online via Kent.gov.uk with 70% of pothole reports to KCC coming through this online fault reporting tool.

However, due to the potential danger of some potholes or road surface defect, it is advised not to wait to report a pothole or road surface defect until your next Parish Council meeting and try to avoid reporting such defects to your Parish Clerk or Parish, District or County Councillor, but to report it direct on line to ensure KCC Highways receives your report within minutes and reduces any risk of errors as a result of information being passed on third hand.






