## **SPECIFICATION (1) YEAR 2020 B 2011 GRASS VERGES**

- To mow all grass verges as per attached areas defined by Capel-le-Ferne Parish Council - Total area 13,404 square metres (See specification attached pages 1-4)
- To strim or cut areas not covered by mower
- All cuttings to lay as they fall, except those on hard standing areas which are to be swept or blown onto grass areas
- To be carried out twelve times during the growing season i.e. (twice a month) April, May, June, July, August and September.
- Also, strim and rake off daffodil areas in late June

## **SPECIFICATION (2) CAPEL-LE-FERNE YEAR 2020 PLAYING FIELDS, LANCASTER AVENUE,**

- To gang mow grass at above site up to boundaries, approximately 16,607 metres square (see specification attached)
- Cutting to be carried out between months of March to October inclusive (8 months). To allow for 16 cuts per season (i.e. 2 per month), the actual timing of cuts to be assessed according to the grass growth rates.
- To maintain length of vegetation between the limits of 30-70 mm.
- To strim and/or cut to all boundaries/perimeter to within area of playing fields
- Site to be left in a tidy condition

## **SPECIFICATION (3) CAPEL-LE-FERNE YEAR 2020 CAPEL STREET, GRASS VERGES, 1 to 19 Capel Street 56 Capel Street to junction with Lancaster Avenue 90 Capel Street to School entrance School entrance to 128 Capel Street**

- To gang mow grass at above areas.
- Cutting to be carried out between months of March to October inclusive (8 months). To allow for 8 cuts per season (i.e. 1 per month), the actual timing of cuts to be assessed according to the grass growth rates.
- To maintain length of vegetation between the limits of 30-70 mm.
- To strim and/or cut to all boundaries/perimeter to within areas.
- Sites to be left in a tidy condition
