Be aware of vehicle crime

A car's window was damaged on Victoria Road, Capel-Le-Ferne between 13/06/2020 – 14/06/2020 overnight.

Nuisance vehicles and speeding

There have been reports of nuisance vehicles, causing obstructions of driveways, junctions and path ways.

Please report obstructions VIA 101 or by making an online report VIA the Kent Police website.

If speeding is witnessed by a uniformed officer, a section 59 warning can be issued. The first part of a section 59 is a warning, a warning is issued if the driver has been seen driving without due care and attention or without reasonable consideration for others. Also, they were causing or likely to cause, alarm, distress or annoyance to others. If the driver is seen again by a uniformed officer within 12 months, committing a similar offence, their vehicle will be seized and they will be charged for recovery and storage of the vehicle.

Abandoned vehicles

Please report abandoned vehicles to the council.

- Names of or if unknown, a description of the offender, as full as possible, including clothing.
