Myself and our KCC Community Warden, Jan, continue to have our joint patrols around the village.

I have liaised with the Deputy Manager from **Aspire Care and Educational Services**. They are excited about bringing their service to the area and working with the local community, as they have received such positive feedback about Capel-Le-Ferne and its residents.

I have made contact with the Primary School to remind parents to be mindful of how they park during drop off and pick up time. Please do not obstruct residents drive ways or obstruct pathways, as wheelchair users and push chairs cannot get past.

Please be aware that it is also an offence to idle your vehicle when it is stationary.

On **7/10/2020** - There was a report made of two males interfering with a residents domestic CCTV. The property was not broken in to and nothing was stolen. I have seized the CCTV footage and submitted an intelligence report.

On **08/10/2020** - There was a report of a male attempting to talk with the children leaving the Capel primary school at the end of the school day.

PCSO's have been in the area around the end of the school day for reassurance. This was the only report and there have been no sightings of a suspicious male since.

On **19/10/2020** - There were 2 reports made regarding dangerous driving on the New Dover Road. Patrols attended and arrested the driver for drink driving.
