New guidance to assist in the recognition of Proscribed Extreme Right Wing Terrorist Organisations.

In response to recent concerns from business about the rise of extreme right wing terrorism and the need to better understand the threat, NaCTSO and our colleagues from Counter Terrorism Policing HQ have produced a document designed to help businesses recognise the signs and symbols associated with proscribed organisations, and how to respond once such a logo, symbol or other marking is identified.

The [guidance](#) is for the use of security professionals to help identify a possible risk and take appropriate action by informing the police.

AC Neil Basu has previously warned that extreme right wing terrorism (XRWT) is the fastest growing terror threat in the UK. The overriding threat to the UK remains from Islamist extremism, but the threat we face from XRWT is very real – proven by the fact that nearly a third of the plots foiled by police and security services since 2017 relate to extreme right wing ideology.

Groups like this spread their poisonous propaganda online and Counter Terrorism Policing will take action against anyone who attempts to draw vulnerable people down a path towards extremist and violence.
