This month marked a change for the Committee as we held an actual meeting in the hall after months of virtual Zoom meetings. It was great to be back together again albeit at 2m intervals. It did enable us to concentrate on the issues at hand, particularly on improvements for the hall. It was decided to replace the electrics in kitchen and small hall for LED fittings and the flat roof, needs to be checked out (as we do annually). Plans are also in hand to paint the hall foyer – sometimes the hall takes on the appearance of the Forth Bridge.

The book sale proved successful with an estimated 400 books sold – the money from refreshments will be going to Action on Homelessness for Folkestone. Thanks should go to Roy Mann and an army of volunteers who turned up to help. Following the Government announcement to delay lifting of restrictions, the planned lunch for new and existing volunteers and residents new to the area, has been postponed until August 7th. Anyone new to the area over the last 18 months will be welcome. We hope to invite some of the hall users to the event, so that you can find out about some of the activities available at the hall. Lunch will be served. Numbers will be restricted because of COVID, even if current rules are lifted. The Farmers' Market is doing well – we have a new cheese stall which will be at the hall every third Tuesday in the month. The better weather has meant, that people can take their teas and coffees outside, although we do have seating inside now, socially distanced. Everyone is given extra time for cleaning at the moment, and we would ask people to both respect and use this, allowing people who have the hall before you to leave the hall before you enter. We are grateful to all those who have shown flexibility and consideration for others when using the hall.

From the Vicarage

Say One For Me – it's the sort of remark that churchgoers sometimes hear as they set off for church on a Sunday morning, usually from a neighbour who's engaged in gardening or washing the car. It also inspired the title of a book that sits on my bookshelf about the fact that there are some people who may not choose to attend church themselves but are nevertheless glad that others do.

For people of faith prayer is as natural as a conversation with a friend. Yet it can be surprisingly controversial. I have seen people bristle at the thought that someone might be praying for them. When Richard Dawkins, the celebrated biologist and outspoken critic of all things religious suffered a minor stroke a few years ago, the Church of England asked for prayers for his recovery on its website – only to be accused by some of 'trolling'!

The discussion went on: if prayer works, great! If it's all nonsense, where's the harm? There are certainly those who are comforted by the thought that others are praying for them – we remember those who have asked for our prayers at our services, and others pray for them privately.

But we live in strange times, and I've recently noticed something that I haven't noticed before: I've taken phone calls from people who I cannot recall ever having spoken to before, but who having been left stressed and anxious by the pandemic want to know that someone is praying for them.

And judging by some of the messages I've received from them, it seems to be working.....Brian.

- Never leave anyone in a closed, parked vehicle - especially infants, young children or animals.





JUNIOR PLAY AREA

New Toddler Climbing Equipment and Replacement of Wet-pour Surfaces, have been "pencilled in" with Contractors. Planning Permission decision is anticipated for early July and works will commence, as and when Contractors can programme them in.

Self-closures to be installed to gates in Junior Play Area and Skatepark due to reports of constantly left open, and a recent incident of defecating in Play Area.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT - HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PLAN

The traffic survey results Have now been accessed by Kent Highways. They have stated: "Capel Street results were considered as "very poor", but as it is <u>not</u> an accident hotspot, having investigated the crash data for the last three years (up to 31/12/2020) and there are no reported incidents, the area does not meet the criteria for a flash sign". Decisions are still under discussion for costings and include; The Councillors are considering the above as it is felt, there is now a need to <u>improve</u> on the latest suggestions; The positions of 20mph repeater signs at a height of 2.1m; slow markings with additional road markings (dragon's teeth) and other option requested, to be considered, a reduction in carriageway width in short sections, with priority from one direction. Further 20mph roundels in the side roads, where they junction with the B2011. Speed surveys on B2011 were disappointing being accessed from "acceptable to good". Further traffic management on this road to be investigated again in future. Parish Council funding will be considered accordingly for all above.

<u>Dover Hill traffic improvement works:</u> Phase 1 works at top of hill, new crossing etc., completed. Phase 2, to alter the single file position, new signage and arrester bed works still to be carried out – date still unknown.
