Crimes of note:

04/12/2021 & 05/12/2021 – LIVESTOCK worry – Sheep were found dead on two farms in **Alkham**. CSI attended and both incidents are being investigated.

13/12/2021 – SUS EVENT – Gravel Lane, **West Hougham**. A male was reported trying to flag vehicles down and standing in front of vehicles on two different occasions. Please be cautious of events like this and put your safety first. Call 999, stay inside your vehicle, and keep it locked.

16/12/2021 – SUS EVENT – Cauldham Close, **Capel-Le-Ferne**. Door to door seller. Male showed the informant identification but too quickly to read. He was trying to sell an item for £20 to a vulnerable/elderly individual. Door to door sellers should have a “pedlars certificate” when door to door selling. If a door-to-door seller is being persistent and not showing ID, please call 999, give a description of the seller, secure any CCTV/doorbell footage you may have, stay inside and lock your property.
