



What do the letter codes mean?



After you have undertaken your sessions you will see various different statuses after the letters have been generated– these are explained below:-

Awaiting Processing	Awaiting Processing
1st Record Observed	1 st Time vehicle observed on the system in a 12-month period.
Letter Sent UN1	Where a handheld device has been used by PSCO or a group.
Letter Sent UN2	Where a handheld device has been used by PSCO or a group and detected a 2 nd observation using the device.
Letter Sent MO2	2 nd Time Vehicle seen on the system in a 12-month period.
Letter Sent MO3	3 rd Time Vehicle seen on the system in a 12-month period.
Hand Delivered HD1	For 4 occasions – hand delivered by uniformed officers
Active Enforcement	Where vehicle has been seen on 4 or more occasions – information passed to officers for awareness and enforcement action if able.
Letter Sent FO1	1 st time Fastest observed where vehicle travelling at 50% or above
Letter Sent FO2	2 nd time Fastest observed where vehicle travelling at 50% or above
Letter Sent FO3	3 rd time Fastest observed where vehicle travelling at 50% or above
Hand Delivered FO1	Fast offender more than 90% above limit – Hand delivered letter
Hand Delivered FO2	2 nd time seen where speed is fast offender more than 90% above limit.
Hand Delivered FO3	Fast offender more than 90% above limit – Hand delivered letter where a 3 rd trigger has occurred
Case Filed	Case filed by CSW team for various reason
Timed out	Where the observation is out of time – 14 day limit
Superseded	Where a further observation has come in before letter has been processed, and the older observation is marked superseded.
Enf.Speeding	Where enforcement support has taken place and how many vehicles detected
DVLA Failed	Where the Make/Colour and registration do not match DVLA records
