The hall now has a new sound system. Our previous one has given us all sorts of fun in the past, as it has been so complicated that a lot of us couldn't use it! The system now installed is a lot easier to operate and hopefully will be widely used by all those hiring the hall. We also have new window winders! The high windows in the main hall have been closed because our old window openers did not work. These have now been replaced which will mean we can have fresh air circulating the hall during the summer. The lights in the hall have also been replaced which means that we have a much clearer and brighter light. The hall floor will be cleaned and the badminton markings replaced in the near future.

Our new Wi-Fi has been delayed as there was no telephone connection to the hall when the telephone engineer tried to install broadband. We've now been told April. And with regret we have decided to cancel the Village Fete. We don't have enough people to man the various stalls we had planned and don't want to run a half-baked affair. Perhaps another year when we have more people involved and willing to take part. On a more positive note, we have a new butcher joining us at the Farmers Market. Rotherwood Butchers, who have a store in Dover, will be coming every week – I speak from personal experience when I say their meat is very good and very reasonable. This means that finally we have bakers, butchers, eggs, fruit and vegetables and of course our French cheese stall the first Tuesday of the month. Together with cakes, jams and our various craft stalls, the number of stalls is gradually increasing. We have had a glitch or two lately – last week we were five stalls down with holidays and even 2 stallholders testing positive for COVID, but things are definitely on the up. We will be having an Easter Bunny hunt for the children at the Farmers Market on the 12<sup>th</sup> April. For more details ask trustees at the Farmers Market.

And finally, because of the recent increase of people in the area with COVID, trustees using the hall will be resuming the wearing of facemasks. While we cannot insist that people using the hall wear masks, we would ask that people consider doing so in the interim.

### From the vicarage

Like most clergy, I have plenty of very weighty, very serious theological books on my shelves – but also others which, although lighter and rather less serious, nevertheless contain pearls of wisdom.

I've been reading one which takes a sideways look at all things religious - including the increasingly popular idea that pictures our departed loved ones smiling as they look down at what we are doing from On High – rather like a celestial TV lounge, perhaps, with angels serving tea. It's not an idea supported by anything found in the New Testament, but many people nevertheless seem to find it attractive - although, as the book points out, it rather loses its appeal when you're in the shower or doing something that you know they would disapprove of.

An inscription on an ancient headstone beside the path in the churchyard at Alkham takes a different view: *He is not dead but sleepeth*. The words come from the gospels, spoken by Jesus to a distraught father whose young daughter had just died, and who he was about to restore to life - words which once offered such hope and comfort to a grieving local family that they chose them to be carved on their loved one's memorial.

For Christians Easter brings with it the celebration of Jesus' resurrection from the dead and the hope of heaven for those who trust in Him. *What no eye has seen, wrote St Paul, nor ear heard, nor the human heart conceived... God has prepared for those who love him.*

To me, that promises that Eternity will be a much more exciting prospect than simply being expected to look down and smile as what's left of my life savings is blown on computer games. I hope so, anyway...



They are appealing to people to knit/Crochet blankets for patients in the Dementia Wards so they can take the blanket on their bed home. Danielle (Dee) was very enthusiastic about the work she did and it came over in her talk. Caroline gave the Vote of Thanks.



Refreshments were then served. Future events included 'New Age Kurling' which was on the 15<sup>th</sup> March 2022. BINGO on the 7<sup>th</sup> March 2022 6.45 for 7.00pm start in Capel-le-Ferne Village Hall. In a preparation for the next Bingo Meeting, we had a practise as some members had never played it before. ### Rural Crime

- \* Secure gates with good quality chains and padlocks that are more difficult to open.
- \* Make sure your animals are chipped or tagged to make them identifiable in case they escape.
- \* Use capped or inverted hinges on field gates to prevent easy removal.
- \* Regularly check gates and boundaries for signs of tampering.

### Protect your garden

- Maintain hedges and fences to prevent unwanted visitors from entering your garden.
- Close your garden gate and lock it from the inside.
- Store bins and ladders carefully so they can't be used as climbing aids.
- Store tools and equipment somewhere secure after use so they don't get stolen or used to break into your home.
- Secure sheds and garages with suitable locks and consider fitting shed alarms and security lights.
- Disable lawn mowers and other large machinery when not in use and chain items together or to a solid anchor point.
- Security-mark valuable items – taking photographs and recording details such as serial numbers and identifying marks can also help to identify items if they get lost or stolen.

The Parish Councillors, at their meeting in March, agreed to register their interest, as an organisation, in wishing to show practical and compassionate assistance towards Ukrainians and to receive further information on the schemes via the Government and Sanctuary Foundation.

We have also encouraged a working party of those showing interest in our community and they will be arranging meetings accordingly.

The government's official sponsorship programme is now open. <https://homesforukraine.campaign.gov.uk/>

Unfortunately, the Government, at the time of this newsletter going to print, is not yet ready to accept communities accepting refugees; The application process for Phase One of the scheme has opened.

\* If you know someone in Ukraine who you can sponsor to come to the UK, therefore please register with the government's scheme, i.e., the name of the individual (or individuals) you would like to sponsor and can accommodate them for at least six months, the next step for you or them is to complete a simplified visa form.

\* If you do not know someone in Ukraine, you will need to wait for the next phase of the sponsorship programme before you can proceed with your registration.

It is heart-warming that so many people, charities, businesses, and faith groups have offered to help. This public response is truly in keeping with our country's long history of helping others in their hour of need. The Government understands that only a fraction of those who have recorded their interest may ultimately be able to sponsor a Ukrainian or Ukrainian family. Many more will support the Ukrainian arrivals, help them integrate in local communities, and welcome them into British society.





### **FROM A CO-ORDINATOR OF CAPEL-LE-FERNE SPEED WATCH TEAM**

Apologies for the long post, but I do hope, fellow villagers, that you will take the time to look through it.

I read with interest, the recent social media posts about speeding vehicles in Capel le Ferne and particularly, Capel Street. It's clear to me, that like myself, a lot of people are concerned about speeding on our village roads and some of the suggestions were not only valid but also very creative!

However, despite all this, none of the suggestions, in my opinion, will ever come to pass. Speed humps have been ruled out by Kent County Council and average speed cameras, whilst a good idea, are not only expensive but the Parish Council, doesn't I believe, even begin to have the budget to implement such a costly solution.

So, what's the answer I hear you say? The answer is simple and it's a scheme that not only has the backing of Kent Police, but also the Parish Council. Sadly however, only about 10 people in the village currently are committed enough to reducing speed on our roads that they are prepared to give up their valuable time and do something about it: Speed Watch.

Let's give you an example. A session held recently, the Capel Speed Watch volunteers set up the equipment in Capel Street, monitoring traffic heading North (towards Dover) between 8am and 10am. Now, you can look at it one of two ways. Out of the 96 vehicles that passed our equipment, 21 were above the required limit to record them. That's 22% of the traffic travelling at an unacceptable speed. Their details will be passed to Kent Police and depending on whether they have been recorded on the Speed Watch system before - anywhere in either Kent or Sussex - action may be taken against them. To give you a little more detail - and we only had 1 offender today - but if vehicles are caught exceeding the limit by more than 50%, Kent Police take a very dim view of this and it may result in immediate action. If they're caught several times, they will get a letter(s) from Kent Police reminding them of their responsibility to drive more carefully and persistent offenders will get a personal visit from a traffic officer.

The other way to look at it, which is actually the one I prefer, is that 78% of the vehicles today, passed us at the correct speed, but I firmly believe that was probably due to our presence. I have no doubt that if we hadn't of been there, probably 90% or more would have exceeded the limit and put our villagers and their children in danger.

Kent Police, for their part, have now committed full-time officers to the Speed Watch initiative and increasingly, we are now joined by a Police officer during our sessions who can, give tickets on-site, to speeding vehicles. We also now use video cameras at the roadside to not only record offenders but also those who feel compelled to hurl abuse at us whilst we go about our work. Again, Kent Police take action against these people, so the scheme really does have some teeth! However, here's the crux. If we had more volunteers who were prepared to just give up maybe a couple of hours or even an hour of their time a week, we could run more Speed Watch sessions! The Parish Council would ideally like to see them every day of the week at the various locations that are approved by the Police throughout the village, as would I.

I believe that this would have the effect of not only catching the offenders, but drivers would start to think twice about travelling through our village at speed as they would never know where and when we would be. The Parish council have also now purchased a new speed indicator device, so now we will have two machines at our disposal and if we had more people, we could run two sites at the same time!

But we need more people! It's as simple as that. So, if you feel as passionate about stopping the speeders as myself, I implore you to sign up to the scheme. It's not only rewarding in that you feel like you are doing something to help the problem, but we have a laugh whilst we do it and are a good bunch of people.

**BUT WE NEED MORE VOLUNTEERS.**

I would point out to those that are undoubtedly going to say it, that I'm afraid we can't operate after dusk or before sunrise. All we can do is try to EDUCATE drivers by running as many sessions as possible, on as many days as possible and that it is NOT ACCEPTABLE to drive through our village at ANYTIME exceeding the limit and that if you do, you will be reported and action may be taken.

So fellow villagers, please get onboard and help out the Capel Community Speed Watch Team, you never know, your actions could make a real difference. Meanwhile, we'll be out again - not telling you where or when 😊 - monitoring speeders for yours and our safety.


