It's amazing how a change (for the better) in the weather can have such a positive effect on one's state of mind. Regulars coming to the Farmers Market are commenting how much better they feel when they see the sunshine. As I write this the sun is shining, the birds are chirping and it is very tranquil outside in the garden. Easter Sunday in Dorset.

Another thing that has had a strong impact on the Trustees, is all the work that has been done in the Hall of late. Thanks, must be given to Fred who has cleaned, painted and polished up the main hall floor a treat. Our next flooring adventure will be replacing the main corridor carpet that has definitely seen better days. The new window winders work a treat, as does the new sound system. This is very easy to operate. Just turn it on at the wall, plug in your electronic device of choice to the relevant cable hanging from the wall and off you go. Each cable is labelled whether HDMI, smart phone etc. For those wishing to use the microphone, this can be used for a small fee. Talk to Sue Leaning who will be able to provide the access to it. We also now have free Wi-Fi across the hall. There is a BT guest Wi-Fi highlighted among your Wi-Fi notifications when you're in the hall – follow the instructions which means essentially a couple of clicks and then you will have access to the net. There is no requirement to login so no email and/or personal details are required. without saying (but I'm going to say it anyway), that the system is protected against malicious and inappropriate use. The next thing is that the old playroom storeroom is due to be used as storage for the hall. All cupboards (apart from CCTV) that are currently in Room 101 - the old post office room - will be transferred to the storeroom near the left-hand side of the stage. Following this, Room 101 will be done up and then used as a small meeting room.



The Farmer's Market is doing well – we hope to be having plant stalls soon to add to the meat, bakery, cakes, fruit and veg, jams and the craft stalls that we have at the moment. I would like to add that if anyone in the village has surplus plants, fruit or vegetables during the summer that they would like to sell but don't have enough to warrant having a stall then bring them to the market and we will try and sell them for you.

I've started to get enquiries about the date of the Garage Safari and if it is going ahead. The answer is yes unless there are unforeseen circumstances. The date will be Sunday 4th September. The Hall is also supporting the Jubilee celebrations particularly the street party which will be held at the recreation ground on Sunday 5th June. We are also contemplating holding a quiz. We look forward to seeing you at these and some of the other events taking place at the hall this summer.

From the vicarage

I boarded the train and found a seat. The man sitting opposite smiled and asked if I had had a good day. I had, I replied, and I asked him how his day had been.

They had celebrated the win, and his young friend was now sprawled across the seat next to him. As I reassured him that I wasn't a Rangers supporter, his friend suddenly began clapping and chanting in honour of the genius who had scored the winning goal. In all honesty, sport and I have never understood each other, and I'm no football fan.

I remembered this when I came across this headline: *Revealed: The most boring person in the world is a religious data-entry worker who watches TV.* It was about a study from the University of Essex. 





We have seen, with horror and disbelief, what has been taking place in Ukraine, something most of us never thought to see happening in Europe either in this century or, indeed, our lifetime.

So many would like to help in some way, but personal circumstances may not allow us to become hosts and negotiating the "red tape" can be both daunting and offputting. Help for Ukraine, though, need not be solely in the form of becoming host to a family or individual.




