From the vicarage

You may have noticed that Archbishop Justin's Easter Day sermon got a bit of a reaction this year – certainly a bigger one than mine did, judging by the newspaper headlines it generated. Archbishops of Canterbury have a way of ruffling feathers, with three having come off especially badly: the Martyrdom in Canterbury Cathedral recalls how Thomas à Becket, having annoyed King Henry II, was murdered there by four of his knights. Thomas Cranmer and William Laud also met sticky ends, one burned on the orders of Mary Tudor, the other executed by Parliament during the English Civil War. Thankfully Archbishop Justin is still in one piece, at least as far as I know.

Approached for a comment, one MP thundered: *The Archbishop... should not assume to know what God knows in my humble opinion.*

This strikes me as odd – a bit like saying that a doctor should not presume to write prescriptions. Christians have always recognised praying and reading the Bible as a way of finding out what God thinks – they don't call the Bible *the Word of God* for nothing. In fact, the laws that govern the Church of England are made by Parliament and oblige its clergy, archbishops included, *not being let by sickness or some other urgent cause*, *to say daily the Morning and Evening Prayer*, *either privately or openly*. So, the law obliges me, and people like me, to read the Bible; and reading it is more likely to prick my conscience than confirm my opinions: I'm left asking whether I have loved God, and my neighbour as

conscience than confirm my opinions: I'm left asking whether I have loved God, and my neighbour as myself, or whether I have judged or condemned anyone, or whether I have forgiven others when I have needed to. So please spare a thought for Archbishop Justin. He's only doing his job. *Brian*





e-scooters – know the law!

With the weather currently treating us well with more people getting out in and around Dover,

this is a timely reminder around current E-Scooter law.

These PLEVs (Personal Light Electric Vehicles) are indeed ever popular and you're likely to have seen people using them out in public.



For the rest of the country, under current law, e-scooters can only be used on private land with the owner's permission. They are treated as motor vehicles and subject to the same legal requirements, such as driving licence, insurance, number plates, lighting, road tax, crash helmets etc.

Without these, e-scooters cannot be used legally on the road, pavements or other public spaces.

For our community, this includes on the Public Playing Field in Lancaster Avenue, CT18 7LX and also, on Capel Street and other surrounding highway, where recently a "near-miss" with a delivery van was witnessed.

Youths repeatedly using the Playing Field early most evenings,

Officers in <u>#Aylesham</u> are appealing for help following the disappearance of a plaque in memory of PCSO Julia James.



As you may be aware, on the 10 February, Kent County Council agreed its budget for 2022/23. In order to meet the ongoing severe financial challenges that the council faces, it was proposed that the discretionary Kent Homeless Connect service could be allowed to end when the contract expires on 30 September 2022.

Instead KCC would work with district, city and borough councils, to find and embed alternative ways of delivering this essential support.

In the meantime, KCC would make transitional funding available for these services until at least March 2023 to ensure no break in service occurs, if this difficult decision is made.

Before any decision, the council intends to conduct a public consultation to understand the potential impact. The consultation is now open and will run for six weeks until 6 June. To give your views on the proposal and find out more information, visit




