With the approach of the summer holidays (as I write this after a mini heatwave it is blowing a hoolie), we are starting to plan work for the hall as traditionally this is our quietest period.

We will be laying new flooring in the hall corridors and decorating this, and the old playgroup storeroom and Room 101 (the old post office room), so called because things go here to be stored and forgotten! The plan is to create a new, small meeting room out of Room 101 and then store things in the storage room next to the stage, ensuring there is a clear walkway between the main hall and the exit door in the storeroom. None of this should interfere with hall activities although if it does, we will give plenty of warning to hall users.

The Garage Safari will be taking place on the 4th September with refreshments and facilities available at the Village Hall. For those wishing to have a stall please contact Cherry Leppard on 01303 255114. These will be marked on the map given out to those wishing to buy on the day. Recent safaris have been very popular and it is a chance to get rid of those things in your home that others may wish to purchase and use. While on the subject of trade, the indoor boot fairs will be taking place in November 2022 and February 2023. A quick reminder also on our quiz night on the 2nd July – it will be £4 each person with a limit of 6 per table and a raffle will be available. Please feel free to bring your own snacks and drinks.

The Farmers' Market is doing very well and continues to be a venue where people can get together for a chat. The Parish Council have their surgery there monthly, the Community Warden is normally in attendance (she can get called away suddenly for the odd meeting) and coffee and tea is always on tap – literally. We do sometimes have an issue with stall attendance as sometimes people have to cancel and also some stalls attend fortnightly or even once a month (French cheese stall springs to mind, first Tuesday of the month). But the bakery and meat continue to be popular and the cakes, jams and eggs also do well. A perusal of the various craft stalls is a must. We look forward to seeing you there.

The hall committee would also like to take the opportunity of thanking all those who helped put away chairs, tables, bunting etc after the Jubilee Street Party. After what was a very enjoyable event organised by the Parish Council, it was great to see so many people helping out afterwards and certainly made our lives very much easier.

From the vicarage

Think of when you last went to a wedding, and you may remember how, between arriving at the venue and the reception itself beginning, there was perhaps an interlude when people could mingle, chat, have a drink and relax. We attended a wedding reception not long ago and, as we waited to go in, a photographer wandered around, taking snaps of the guests as they chatted.

Now it's one thing to have your photo taken when you've had the chance to comb your hair and straighten your tie. But it's quite another when you're snapped as you pulled a face at something that you were being told, and the result isn't guaranteed to be flattering. The photos duly circulated a few days later; *do I really look like that?* I wondered, looking at a snap of my open-mouthed self, my glasses perched on the end of my nose.

3rd July is the feast day of St Thomas - *Doubting Thomas* as he is often known from the unflattering snapshot of him in St John's gospel. You may know the story: Jesus, risen from the dead, appeared to his disciples when Thomas wasn't there. Later, they told Thomas what they had seen; he refused to believe it until a week later, when he saw Jesus for himself.

But less well known is the tradition that Thomas went on to travel to India where he founded several churches. He is rumoured to have been martyred near modern Chennai. In the end faith, rather than doubt, sustained him on his travels, and at the end. He became India's patron saint.

Thomas and his doubts; me and my open mouth - it all goes to show just how misleading a single snapshot can be... *Brian*

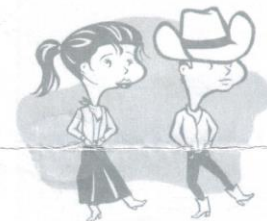

Parish Council Chairperson's Report July 2021 – April 2022

Play Equipment. The multi-coloured surfaces in the junior play area were completed in Autumn 2021. Self-closing hinges on the gates have finally been installed.

Thanks to Keith for regularly checking the play equipment area and reporting any issues that need to be addressed.

Speed Watch. This is going from strength to strength. New volunteers have joined and several new sites have been approved. More sessions are now taking place.

New equipment has been purchased to replace the older, outdated gear.

Platinum Jubilee. A working party was formed to take this forward. The Street Party is to take place in the Village Hall car park on Sunday 5 June, 2022.

Bunting has been made by a group of 10 volunteers.

The beacon lighting will take place on Thursday 2 June at the Battle of Britain Memorial site following a candlelight procession from the Village Hall.

Commemorative mugs have been purchased to give to every child in Capel School.

105 saplings are to be planted with the help of local schoolchildren as part of the Queen's Green Canopy in the recreation ground.

Resilience Plan. This is still being updated on a regular basis including a map of the location of fire hydrants throughout the village including the new development.

Grapevine Newsletter. This continues to be produced in colour following a trial period and residents' approval.

Highways Improvement Plan. Working party is still meeting to discuss and update this.

The double yellow lines in Capel Street and 20mph signs at various location across the village are now completed.

Noticeboards. It was agreed that these were no longer required. Amin Stores and Capel School have adopted the ones on their sites. The one outside the Church is being relocated to Greenview Nursery and the Village Hall one is being disposed of as it is not in a good state of repair.

Afternoon Tea Party. This was held in March to thank the volunteers who deliver the Grapevine and run Speed Watch. A very successful event and enjoyed by all who attended.

I would like to thank our Parish Councillors for their continuing support. Also, Maureen and Keith for helping me settle into my new role and gently guiding and advising me when I need it.

On behalf of the Parish Council, appreciation goes to the Community Warden, Jan Henry, and PCSO, Megan Keehner, for their input in the village. Sadly, we are losing Megan who is being replaced by Eva Winter following a reshuffle. We welcome Eva and look forward to working with her. *Philippa Seager*

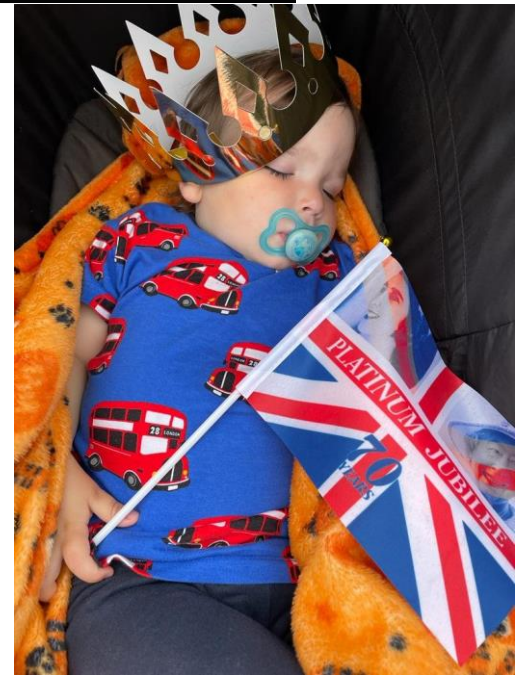

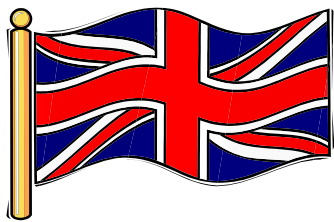

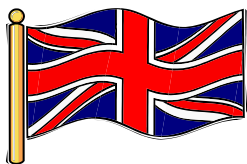


CAPEL-LE-FERNE TWINNING ASSOCIATION

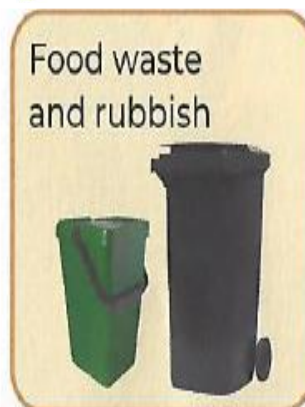
