Recent enquiries have thrown up a discussion on how the hall is run and I thought it would be useful to highlight what happens and why, particularly for those who have come to the village since the hall was built.

The current hall was built in the 1980s and is owned by the community, which is represented by the Board of Trustees, all non-paid volunteers. What they can do is outlined by the halls governing document which dates from the previous village hall (1952) and which was updated in the 1970s and 1980s. A non-profit organisation, we are registered with the Charity Commission (charity number 281786) who also have their own rules on how the hall should be run. Often people think the hall is run by the Parish Council, but although we have an excellent working relationship with the Council, our two organisations are entirely separate. I should add that the land around us including the play area and the recreation ground is run by the Parish Council, but the car park in front of the hall is ours and as such, is private land. The Trustees meet monthly attended by their own agenda and minutes. For urgent matters requiring a decision, we are in contact by email which is then ratified at the following meeting. During COVID we still met but by Zoom.

One of the things highlighted by the COVID shutdown, was just how much it costs to run the hall. On a standing start this is about £1400-1500 per month. It includes insurances, utilities, cleaning and lettings services. These last two are provided as a contracted-out service and are vital to the successful running of the hall. Maintenance is not included in this figure and as mentioned in previous months, is an ongoing issue with its own regular spot on the monthly meeting agenda. We work on the theory that lettings of the hall, both by clubs and private individuals, pay for the running of the hall while maintenance and big renovation projects, are sponsored by fundraisers such as the Garage Safari, indoor boot fairs and any grant applications we make. It is therefore important that we have these fundraisers because although they require a fair bit of organising, they are instrumental in keeping up standards at the hall.

Stall money at the Safari, refreshments at the boot fairs, Farmers Market and even the book sales, all go to help us fix windows, replace flooring, put in new ovens and install new lighting and sound equipment: all of these have been done over the past 6 months.

The hall is a hub for many organisations including the Youth Club, Judo, WI, Indoor Bowls, Badminton, Car Club, Bridge Club, Gardeners Association and various fitness and dance classes. The Parish Council also hold their meeting there, as well as a monthly surgery at the Farmers Market. The Farmers Market which has been running for nearly 20 years now, provides a space for people to meet up as well as providing the various food and craft stalls. A sense of community is very important to the hall and to run the hall efficiently, we are reliant on our volunteers. However, this merry band of people is diminishing, and we do need more, as I believe I have mentioned on more than one occasion.

So, there we have it; a brief overview of the hall and how it is run. We look forward to seeing you there.

This month I have a confession to make; I've been spotted indulging in my latest guilty pleasure.

But I don't think of myself as getting old. It's not so long ago that I was still working in schools as a supply teacher. 
