From the vicarage

There are moments when the world changes; moments we'll look back upon, remembering where we were and what we were doing when we heard about what had happened.

Perhaps the loss of our Queen will prove to be one of those moments. She had been there for as long as most of us can remember. She was full of years, and her passing was not entirely unexpected. And yet... suddenly the world has changed.

I never met her, have no personal stories to tell, and saw her in the flesh just once. But as Supreme Governor of the Church of England she was my boss. I swore allegiance to her when I was ordained, and when I was licensed to this parish.

In a world in which Christians sometimes risk being thought odd, superstitious or amusing, she never disguised the fact that her faith was real, authentic – not just something to which she paid lip service because of the position she held. Our reading from St John Chapter 6 speaks of the hope by which she lived, and with which we commend her into God's keeping.

Most of us expect to retire from our employment at some point – but her example reminds us that there are some things from which we never retire. Despite her declining health she remained Queen to the end – still working, still true to her calling, still the person God had called her to be. A reminder that we, too, never lay down our calling to be the people God calls us to be.

Today, we give thanks for her faith, integrity and sense of duty, for a life well lived. We pray for King Charles III, the Royal Family and for ourselves, facing a changing world.



Visitors from overseas joined local residents as the Trust once again marked Battle of Britain Day on 15 September with a short Service of Remembrance.

This year's Battle of Britain Day service was led as always by The Rev Brian Williams with support from site manager Jules Gomez and Trustee Andy Simpson, both of whom then laid wreaths at the National Memorial to the Few. Those attended also observed a reflective two-minute silence.

This year's event, which was again supported by standard bearers, had a particular poignancy as it happened just a week after the death of Her Majesty the Queen, who opened The Wing in 2015.

Media interest surrounding Her Majesty and her links with Kent meant that a reporter from KMTV and a film crew from BBC South East attended the event, while Radio Kent's 10am to 2pm show hosted by Steve Ladner was broadcast live from the site, helping to raise awareness of the work of the Trust and of the Memorial.



CAPEL-LE-FERNE PARISH COUNCIL

Summary of some items discussed at meeting Tuesday, 20th September 2022



<u>Requests from public and Other Feedback</u>: Items raised, discussed by Councillors under related entries.

- ➤ Vehicle parked junction B2011/Alexandra Road.
- A20 lay-bys in need of litter clear-up.
- New Dover Road pavement repairs reported.
- New resident request for delivery of Grapevine.
- Large assembly of scaffolding Capel Street, confirmed was for planning application of 2 dormer window extension.

Planning:

Following decision made by DDC Planning Committee, the application for Longships, Cauldham Lane was granted permission, with conditions. Councillors requested and agreed communication be forwarded to Dover District Council Members, on the incorrect comments made at the meeting by the Applicant's Architect regarding communication issues with Parish Council, which was proved inaccurate. Both District and County Councillors addressed the Parish Council meeting on their decisions relating to this application.

Traffic Management and Highways:

- ➤ TAP Meetings continue to take place regarding issues with Dover Harbour Board and French resources, with negotiations being a work in progress.
- ➤ Highway Improvement Plan (HIP) submitted to Kent Highways, excluding yellow lines outside Village Hall.

Pubic Rights of Way:

- Green Lane responsibility from Old Dover Road to New Dover Road under further investigations with Management Agents of George Close Development.
- ➤ Green Lane clear-up had been a great success. Ivy cut back from trees undertaken. Thanks were expressed to Teams of Volunteers who attended.

Speed Watch: All results of sessions are available on Parish Council Website. More volunteers required to join our Team to help educate all drivers in our Village (more details page 11).

Events: Jubilee/Memory Photo Book, amended to take account passing of HM Queen Elizabeth II. Budget for future Coronation celebrations agreed.

Resilience Plan: Continues to be a work in progress.

<u>Capel Cares</u>: Details of next meetings on page 5. Monthly coffee meetings now in large hall. <u>Ukraine</u>: Cllr Seager attended a virtual NALC training session on refugee help. DDC offer meetings for refugees, details to be forwarded to hosts.

<u>Grapevine Newsletter/social media</u>: Holiday dates of deliverers being filled by other volunteers.

<u>Village Hall</u>: Full report on Page 2. Management Committee agreed the following; not to install double yellow lines opposite car park; due to responsibility requirements not to install a flag-pole; new car park sign would be installed; collating a photo collage of Jubilee and commemorative plaque commissioned.

<u>Training/workshops/seminars</u>: Members circulated available courses.

Thank you everyone who attended the Reading of the Accession Proclamation, Sunday, 11th September 2022, at the Village Hall. Parish Council Chairperson, Philippa Seager, informed those present: We come together this afternoon following the passing of our late Sovereign, Queen Elizabeth the Second. Our sadness at this time is shared by people across the globe, as we remember with affection and gratitude, the lifetime of service given by our longest reigning Monarch. But, the basis on which our monarchy is built, has ensured that through the centuries, the Crown has passed in an unbroken line of succession. Today's ceremony marks the formal Proclamation to the people of the Parish of Capel-le-Ferne, of the beginning of our new King's reign. Yesterday the Accession Council met at St. James's Palace to proclaim our new Sovereign. The Accession Council also made an Order requiring High Sheriffs to cause the Proclamation to be read in the areas of their jurisdiction. The High Sheriff of Kent discharged that duty earlier today and now, with my humble duty, I now bring the words of the Proclamation to the residents in the Parish of Capel-le-Ferne. This was followed by singing of the first verse of the national anthem and three cheers for His Majesty the King.

Whereas it has pleased Almighty God to call to His Mercy our late Sovereign Lady Queen Elizabeth the Second of Blessed and Glorious Memory, by whose Decease the Crown of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland is solely and rightfully come to The Prince Charles Philip Arthur George: We, therefore, the Lords Spiritual and Temporal of this Realm and Members of the House of Commons, together with other members of Her late Majesty's Privy Council and representatives of the Realms and Territories, Aldermen and Citizens of London, and others, do now hereby with one voice and Consent of Tongue and Heart publish and proclaim that The Prince Charles Philip Arthur George is now, by the Death of our late Sovereign of Happy Memory, become our only lawful and rightful Liege Lord Charles the Third, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of His other Realms and Territories, King, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith, to whom we do acknowledge all Faith and Obedience with humble Affection; beseeching God by whom Kings and Queens do reign to bless His Majesty with long and happy Years to reign over

Given at St. James's Palace this tenth day of September in the year of Our Lord two thousand and twenty-two.
