



From the vicarage

I find that packing a bag and heading off with my Senior Railcard to somewhere with a cathedral, pleasant walks, and interesting things to see is a good way of recharging my batteries – though, I've learned that there's really no such thing as being off duty.

I recently headed for Bristol, which indeed does have a cathedral, pleasant walks, and interesting things to see. But while there I took the bus through the Mendip Hills to Wells - England's smallest city – and then on to Glastonbury, with its associations with King Arthur and Joseph of Arimathea, its ruined abbey, sacred thorn, and famous Tor – which yes, I did manage to climb.

My trusty smartphone led me to the bus stop, and I arrived with twenty minutes to wait. Along with a woman with her shopping and mums with children and pushchairs, a middle-aged man in a shabby grey suit sat chain-smoking and clutching a can.

He thought he knew me from somewhere. I wasn't local, I told him, but from Kent. At once I found myself discussing St Augustine, King Ethelbert, and Queen Bertha – he had, he said, studied History at university.

When he learned that I planned to visit Wells he told me that he had once been a chorister at Wells Cathedral. He had known a well-known Church of England cleric - a good priest, he said, but probably bound for Hell.

How was I to respond? *Let's hope not*, I replied. I simply listened as he shared his thoughts on churches and psychiatric units. Then the bus arrived. *Enjoy Wells*, he said, smiling.

Later, in Wells Cathedral, I prayed and lit a candle for my new friend. And yes, it's true - there's no such thing as being off duty... *Brian*





This scam is becoming more realistic as they impersonate family members. If you receive this text, think twice before replying. Report scam texts to 7726 and then delete.

#ALERT | Courier Fraudsters targeting residents in Tenterden.

Kent Police have reported courier fraudsters targeting residents, pretending to be a Police Officer. They claimed they arrested someone in possession of their bank card and asked the resident to co-operate with the investigation by withdrawing money which will then be collected by a courier.

Unsuspecting victims hand over the money with the promise that the money will be reimbursed later - however there is no further contact and the money is never seen again.

Watch out! The Police will never ask you to withdraw cash to hand over to a courier. If you get a call like this, call the Police on 101 or dial 999 if they are due to come to your house. You can also get free scams advice from Citizens Advice on 0808 223 1133.





#ScamAlert An electricity scam is targeting Kent residents, pretending to be from Government. They will send a link for you to claim credit towards your electricity bill and will ask you questions about your electricity and details on your bank card. This is a SCAM Be wary of your bank calling you and telling you there is suspicious activity on your account. If you receive a call like this - Stop, hang up and call 159 to speak directly with your bank.




