I hope you have been enjoying the recent hot weather. After weeks of moaning about the cold wind blowing through Capel, I find I am complaining now about the heat — the hall luckily remains cool regardless.

We are entering upon a time when we are busy organising events at the hall. Our standing remit to provide a community centre where people can gather continues so clubs and organisations such as judo, bowls, car club, bridge, quilting, children's dance, twirlers, yoga, Pilates not to mention the WI and the Farmers Market all use the hall whether main or small. We obviously also let the hall for private parties such as birthdays, anniversaries and the occasional wedding. But on top of this we are organising free of charge community lunches for which we now have outside funding, a bingo evening and of course the Garage Safari which takes place on the 3rd September. For anyone wishing to book a table and get put on the village event map, please put your name and address on an envelope marked with Garage Safari with a fiver inside and put through the door at 29 Albany Road. Or leave with Sally Cook at the Farmers Market on a Tuesday morning. We are investing in new Garage Safari Road banners for the event and will be advertising across the net. indoor boot fairs will start again in November with the second one taking place in February next year. Hard to believe that we are already looking ahead to 2024.

The saga of the village hall roof goes on. As part of the work, the skylight, which has been causing all of the problems, was to have been lifted out, the surrounding area renewed and then the skylight replaced. We now find that the skylight has been glued over sealing the bolts

which are needed to undo the window. So, we now have to spend another £3000 on a new skylight. This has further delayed the fitting until the new skylight has been constructed. We apologise for any inconvenience this is causing and assure you that both ourselves and the roofers are doing their best to finish the roof as soon as possible. On the plus side, the temporary tarpaulin held during recent thunder storms although the reverse of that is that the drains couldn't cope with the downpour and we had a flood through the main doors. We have called out the drain company and hope to have had it fixed by the time you read this. Thus, the life of a village hall; community lunches, village Safaris, recalcitrant roofs and overflowing drains.

We tried using Facebook to find out who our visitor was, and three possible candidates were suggested - but he hasn't been back.

The other is his rather larger mum, who spent her first month with us in whatever hiding places she could find. The evening began with Vanessa giving a brief account of the history of Belly Dancing. It seems there is no such thing as a belly dance! It may be the Western pronunciation for a dance originally from the village of Baladi. "Rachs sh ha" is probably a more correct term. It is recognised as a dance empowering women, especially when they dance together. There are even neolithic cave paintings & really ancient pottery which shows women using similar movements. If you've ever wondered about joining the happy band of volunteers at the Battle of Britain Memorial but weren't sure what to expect, here's your chance to find out more. The Battle of Britain Memorial Trust is inviting anyone with an interest in helping out at this popular clifftop Memorial to pop in for a chat on Thursday 27 July. This will be a great opportunity to chat to staff members and other volunteers about what's involved. They're a friendly bunch! The Memorial is home to the National Memorial to the Few, a tribute to the men who fought to protect this country from invasion in the Battle of Britain.

Many of the aircrew paid the ultimate price to secure our freedom – and the Trust is now looking for people to give just a few hours a week to help run this much-loved tribute to those who served in 1940. It's no exaggeration to say that the Trust depends on its volunteers for its very survival. Since the opening of The Wing, the number of people needed to staff the shop, café and other areas has increased considerably, and as a charity with no government or local government funding, it simply can't afford to employ more staff.



Volunteers are the lifeblood of the site, greeting visitors, serving in the café and manning the tills in our well-stocked gift shop. Others help out by keeping the gardens tidy or doing other tasks.

The Memorial is open from 10am to 5pm in the summer and until 4pm in the winter, and we are particularly short of volunteers at the weekends. Full training is provided, no previous experience is needed and you certainly don't need to be a history buff. All we are looking for is a willing pair of hands and a smile!

Neighbourhood Watch:

- > The anti-social dog owner no longer appears to be an issue.
- Noisy neighbours, criminal incidents if no-one is prepared to make an official report either to the Police or Environmental Health, = no action.
- ➤ In February 2023, KCC agreed a planned budget for 2023-24 which included a significant reduction to the Community Warden service funding. No immediate changes to the service level you have come to expect from the community warden service at present. When the public consultation is live, stakeholders will be informed.

Traffic Management and Highways:

- ➤ Blocked PROW at Satmar, Landowner to undo what's been done. Long-term and ongoing.
- Removal of tree struck by lightning, side Village Hall, agreed. More details page 16.





I am pleased to report that after some emails and calls on their part, they have finally got a straight answer from the EBSS office.

Once applications are accepted, they are passed onto the Local Council, which is confirmed as DDC. (There has been raised concerns from residents that when they have reached DDC they were told it was not their responsibility)

Sharon Harvey (Council Tax Manager mob. 07738 321761) is happy to take calls on this. Residents are also reminded that the £400 EBSS payment only relates to a main residence and that as a main residence, there should also be a current Council Tax account at the property.


