No immediate changes to the service level you have come to expect from the community warden service at present. When the public consultation is live, stakeholders will be informed.

Alternative route blocked. Diversion issues with Landowners to be resolved by KCC PROW Officer by enforcement if necessary. Residents' percentage survey to be made available to Councillors.
- Removal of tree struck by lightning, side Village Hall. Action/Resolution: Proposed by Cllr: Seager, seconded by Cllr. Lake and agreed by all present to accept quotation, received from B Young's Grounds Maintenance, for immediate removal for safety purposes.
- Request to have hedge annual cut, top Capel Street. Action/Resolution: Cllr. Young to make enquiries to get done in July, when birds flown.


