

From the vicarage

At my other job as a supply teacher one afternoon, I worked with some students who were soon to sit their Maths GCSE exam. As they finished coursework and practiced past exam papers, one looked up: " $Ere\ Sir - are\ you\ a\ vicar$?"

They thought I sounded like one, apparently – and my cover was soon blown. Fascinated at having a supply teacher who doubled as a vicar, questions began to flow.

"Don't Christians say that God's everywhere?" one girl asked. I replied that they do. She turned pale. "So, whatever you're doing, God knows about it..."

The idea bothered her – but she was right. 'O Lord, you have searched me and known me...' says Psalm 139. 'You know when I sit down and when I rise up... Where can I flee from your presence? If I ascend to heaven, you are there... 'Yes, Christians do believe that God's everywhere. November begins with All Saints' Day. While others are preoccupied with ghoulies, ghosties and four-legged

posties, Christians celebrate the lives of saints. I used to serve in a church that was shared with a Greek Orthodox congregation. Like other Orthodox churches it was decorated with pictures of the saints. We were in their company; their eyes seemed to follow you around, and if that felt unnerving, it nevertheless held out the comforting thought that whatever life brings, we never journey through it alone. The saints are everywhere, too.

A last word from St John of the Cross, a Spanish Carmelite monk. He once spoke with a nun who was frantic with worry about what God thought of the life she'd lived. "Don't worry," he said. "At the Judgement, you will

be judged by someone who loves you." ... Brian





Update on 30th anniversary fundraising campaign

To bring the battle to life across generations, the Trust needs help with a £1m appeal to extend Hunting Lodge and install two high-tech simulators, allowing visitors to experience the thrill – and fear – of an aerial duel against a determined enemy. The simulators we hope to purchase will create an experience, replicating the experiences of a Battle of Britain fighter pilot. Summary of some items discussed at meeting Tuesday, 17th October 2023



Requests from public and Other Feedback:

Planning:

Hearing with Inspectorate on DDC Land Allocation Plan Examination (Capel), being held on 5th December at Council Offices. Councillors accepted experts' quote on receiving advice and guidance on addressing the hearing.

Neighbourhood Watch:

- ➤ Neighbour dispute ongoing via Community Warden and Police Officer.
- ➤ Use of motorised vehicle on playing field dealt with.

Playing Field and Equipment:

- ➤ Due to deterioration, quotes to be obtained on replacement of skateboard ramp, and toddler swing.
- ➤ Holes etc., to grass surface in various locations, damaged by vandalism and wildlife, now filled in.
- Further monitoring on reinstated goal posts ongoing.
- ➤ Investigation being undertaken for the installation of "rebound goal mesh panels".

- Lack of tactile surface for new drop kerbs under investigation.

TV LICENSE SCAM

Kent resident targeted with TV License scam

Resident received an email to pay for their TV License. The next day a scammer called them saying he was from the residents bank and they were a victim of fraud and was asked to give their credit card details.

The TV Licensing guidance says:

- We include the name and/or part of your postcode in our emails. Many scams simply use your email address or say 'Dear Customer'.
- ✓ We send our emails

from donotreply@tvlicensing.co.uk (or donotreply@spp.tvlicensing.co.uk).

- ✓ If you are a TV Licensing payment card customer and you make mobile payments via the TVL Pay app, you may receive emails from noreply@paypoint.com. The sender's name will show as 'TVL Pay'.
- ★ Scammers often hide the true email address they're using, check the email address. On your device, select the sender's name (or email address) to show the actual email address.






