





### From the vicarage

Here's an opportunity – a Victorian property in Chester close to the cathedral, city centre and railway station. To the rear, spectacular views across the River Dee into North Wales. Yours for £100,000, but with a very leaky roof. Or if you want to stay closer to home, £500,000 secures a distinctive piece of 1960s architecture situated on the seafront at St Leonards.

A little-known corner of the Church of England website lists redundant churches for sale. Some are converted for commercial use, others become executive homes or flats - and therefore off limits to anyone wanting a trip down Memory Lane - while others, sadly, are demolished.

Fortunately, others, like our own St Mary's, Capel le Ferne, will pass to the Churches Conservation Trust (CCT) which acquires those that are of historical interest and opens them to the public.

Services are held at St Mary's about three times a year, weather permitting. The church is swept beforehand, and dead leaves, deceased insects and so on removed. Although the church might look neglected, it really isn't, it's just redundant – the CCT check it regularly, and their contractors deal with any repairs needed.

Someone recently expressed an interest on social media in forming a group who might like to help to clean the church. I contacted the CCTs Local Community Officer Nick Watts, who writes:

It would be fantastic if there are some locals who are willing to support the church, but I must stress that they are currently not permitted to do any repairs or heavy cleaning. This is of course a grade I listed structure, and the group would be in breach of Historic England's heritage listing status if they did anything without the CCTs consent. Interested? 



Help us bring history to life

The Battle of Britain Memorial Trust is looking for your support in their fundraising campaign to extend Hunting Lodge and install two high-tech simulators that will recreate the experiences of a Battle of Britain fighter pilot. These simulators will allow visitors to experience the thrill - and fear - of an aerial duel against a determined enemy and keep the memory of the Few alive in an extraordinary way. With your help, we can reach our £1m target and purchase two simulators that will create a multiplayer scenario, with one being a Spitfire and the other a BF109. If we reach our goal, the simulators will include complete replica aircraft cockpits, making the experience even more immersive.

### TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT IN CAPEL-LE-FERNE (Highway Improvement Plan)



Parish Council (PC) Working Party of Councillors held an online meeting with, the Community Engagement Officer (Dover & Thanet), Road Safety and Active Travel Group from Kent Highways (KH). The following priority items were requested and responses received.

#### B2011

<u>PC Enquiry</u>: Re-introduction of fixed Speed Indicator Flashing Devices on B2011, between the 40mph zone East and West of village. <u>KH Response</u>: Speed surveys (i.e. cable on road, counting vehicles and their speed) being organised by Kent Highways to evidence the speeding situation for future decision making.

<u>PC Enquiry</u>: Cost payable by Parish Council if survey warrant signs and/or other traffic management advice.

KH Response: £7,000 plus for each Activated Sign. Councillors to decide on position of signs if agreed.

<u>PC Enquiry</u>: Suggested locations - one near to Battle of Britain site, one near to George Close. <u>KH Response</u>: Discuss further.

PC Enquiry: Likelihood of getting a change of speed limit from 40mph to 30mph.

<u>KH Response</u>: Probably would not be feasible from the Kent Design Team, due to nature of road being straight, double carriageway and sufficient lighting in situ. But will re-visit if speed survey supports the criteria required for any change.

#### Other items discussed:

<u>PC Enquiry</u>: Missing tactile paving on drop kerbs installed recently. <u>KH Response</u>: To be installed during May. Those in private driveways - not feasible, due to constant excess with private use, causing on-going maintenance issues.

<u>PC Enquiry</u>: Introduction of double yellow lines Capel Street at "pinch point" between Lancaster Avenue to School and pavement parking issues. <u>KH Response</u>: Design Team would need to carry out assessment, which Parish Council would have to pay for, i.e. in excess of £4,000 for Traffic Regulation Order and design fees. It was considered unlikely the Design Team would recommend, but suggestion was for Parish Council to carry out an "informal engagement" with residents directly involved, stating there will be a loss of on-road parking for all. Contact to be made with KCC School Travel Department, to provide educational information for circulating to drivers.

#### THE VILLAGE "HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PLAN"

Now being updated accordingly with the above and waits further intervention for the future.

These requests, were suggested from some of our community. However, the Parish Councillors are asking you, all residents, to now have your say on above, i.e. any approvals, objections, comments and/or views, to go forward on these items, especially on the informal engagement to supply double yellow lines in Capel Street as suggested above.
