

From the vicarage

Our son, who works as a school science technician, arrived home with a flowerpot containing a lemon tree grown from a pip. Having started life in a corner of one of the science labs it now needed a "forever home." We found it a spot on the kitchen windowsill, and it has been there ever since.

It was just a couple of inches high with a few glossy green leaves when it arrived. But despite our best efforts, it did not grow. The leaves lost their shine and shrivelled away. Just a stalk remained – and so it has been ever since. It looks dead, but the stalk remains green. It is not growing, but it refuses to die.

Believe it or not, there are gardening tips in the Bible! For example, Jesus once told a story about a landowner who, having planted a fig tree and not had any fruit from it for three years, told his gardener to cut it down. But the gardener persuaded his boss to wait – he would dig around the tree and put manure on it. If it still did not bear fruit, then it could be cut down.

Jesus' stories always have a double meaning. Jesus knew about plants – and people. His point was that we can all be like fruitless trees - going through life being foolish and selfish, and messing things up. But at the same time, we can always make new beginnings and turn our lives around so that we "bear fruit", as Jesus would put it.

Most people would have thrown that lemon tree out by now. But whenever I look at it, I think of Jesus' story about the fig tree, and about second chances. So, I will dig around that little tree, feed it, and see what happens..... *Brian*



CAPEL-LE-FERNE PARISH COUNCIL

Summary of some items discussed at meeting held Tuesday, 17th June 2025



Requests from public and Other Feedback:

- Trees opposite Battle of Britain site, require cut back.
- Request for a "dog exercise area" on Playing Field. After considering cost involved in the way of fencing, installing dog bins and waste removal, Councillors decided that spending public funds could not be justified on this, in view of more than adequate space, with no Dover District Council Public Space Protection Order (PSPO), in the location, for dog owners to let dogs of the lead and run free. Councillors would review in three years' time.

Matters Concerning the Parish:

- ➤ Flooding Capel Street/Lancaster Avenue: Kent Forum, Parish Council, and residents continue to reach out to KCC to review, the lack of maintenance regime of the drainage in this vicinity. More meetings requested and planned with other agencies.
- ➤ Health and Safety documents and Risk Assessments
 Council continue to monitor relevant documents of
 contractors.
- ➤ <u>Land Gifted to Parish Council</u>

 Title Deeds still waiting Executor signature, being chased with Solicitor, again.
- ➤ <u>Bus Shelter (B2011/Winehouse Lane)</u>
 Repairs undertaken by Dover District Council have now been complete, with a remarkable improvement noted.

Planning:

- ➤ Issues concerning contractors working at development in Cauldham Lane, were relayed by Councillors to the Director of Aile Homes, at a working party meeting held. Feedback notes attached to minutes.
- ➤ <u>All planning application documents and comments</u>
 Available to view on Dover District Council website:

<u>Neighbourhood Watch (NHW)</u>: Community Warden report:

- > Stolen scooter from Playing Field reported.
- ➤ Water leak Capel Street, a cause for concern on who is responsible for repairing.
- ➤ Issue with cold caller company, relating to solar panel installations. Reported to Trading Standards.
- ➤ Inconsiderate parking at School, reported to Kent Police and DDC Parking Team.

<u>CCTV/ICT</u>: Ongoing set-up of iCloud and new laptop. Email address change to be notified when arranged.

Playing Field and Equipment:

➤ Bi-monthly report presented to meeting. Corrosion noted to part of swing frame to be dealt with.

Public Rights of Way: No report.



Traffic Management and Highways:

- ➤ Vehicle activated signs on New Dover Road (B2011), still waiting response from Kent Highways Design Team on locations and cost involved.
- ➤ Cut back to hedge in Capel Street ongoing. Status to be requested.
- ➤ Hurst Lane status for re-surface to be addressed again.
- ➤ Diversion signs on M20/A20, when Roundhill Tunnels closed, requiring an update.



DOORSTEP

Doorstep criminals active in Folkestone and Dover Reports from the Lynwood area of Folkestone of a driveway & patio company cold calling and pushing to start work straight away. In Dover, cold callers were knocking on doors offering to tarmac potholes and patch driveways. One resident expected to pay a couple of hundred pounds for the work but the criminals demanded tens of thousands. Doorstep criminals (also known as rogue traders, cowboy builders, building and gardening scammers) cold call on unsuspecting households offering convincing deals to try to get you to agree to having work carried out. We know that if you accept work from a doorstep criminal you will pay much more than you intended for very poor, unnecessary, and sometimes dangerous work. Never respond to cold callers! Request a free NO COLD CALLERS door sticker. If you need work done on your home or garden use a safe, local trader that has been vetted by Kent Trading Standards. Look out for others, report active doorstep criminals to Kent Police on 101. You can also report it to the

charity CrimeStoppers on 0800 555 111. You will stay 100% anonymous, always.

Your camera footage could be used to support investigations, bringing criminals to justice, and making your area a safer place to live.

Watch out for scams relating to the Household Support Fund (HSF) The Department of Work and Pensions (DWP) are warning that fraudsters are attempting to pose as processors for applications for HSF, and are requesting a sum of "refundable" monies to process applications within a short period. The scam appears to duplicate the 'Funded by UK Government' logo, and communications have come from an inbox titled "HSF Applications", with the email address 'hsfaaplications@gmail.com'. The use of non-official email addresses or inboxes, and the spelling issues within the name of both, are tell-tale signs of a scam. 

Since last publication - 7 Sessions have taken place. With 66 offenders being reported to Kent Police,

speeding on New Dover Road (B2011), ranging from 46mph to 59mph.

This included a "Countywide Day of Speed Watching," on 6th June, when 4 sessions were held over 5 hours. Offenders recorded for that day were 35.

One member of the Team attended the Speed Watch Conference on 14th June 2025, with other members. It appears our figures are getting worse, which was noted by the Chief Inspector.

Capel hold the record for the top speeder in a 40mph zone, of 90mph. Also, in the top 5 for cars speeding in a 20mph zone and represented in almost every other chart.

The Speed Van has attended during the last month and caught 46 offenders. Speed Watch signs have been attached to street furniture on New Dover Road.




