From the vicarage

Lord Nelson would not have been impressed by HMS Victory's paintwork, nor by the fact that its sails had been glued on back-to-front. I was probably just about six years old when I was given my first Airfix kit (remember those?) It was the first of many, and with each one that followed I learned how to follow instructions, how to glue parts together neatly, and how to paint my models to match the pictures on the boxes. It was great fun - I spent hours making them. With patience and perseverance, I eventually achieved results that were worth the trouble taken and time spent.

I spoke recently with someone whose work brings him into contact with what he calls 'The Amazon Generation'. We have become so used to online shopping, he believes, that patience and perseverance in everyday life are giving way to impatience. A couple of taps on a smartphone, and all that remains is to wait for the delivery van to arrive – which we almost expect to happen yesterday.

Some say that prayers never go unanswered – it is just that we find 'No' or 'Wait' harder to cope with than 'Yes.' My acquaintance would say that some of his clients also struggle to be patient when they do not get exactly what they want just when they want it. Online shopping, he might say, has a lot to answer for.

It is an interesting point. In a gift shop the other day, I came across a kit that makes up into a model of a Spitfire. No glue, paint - or patience - is required. It snaps together in minutes, with perfect results every time.

But I still say that if you have never spilt glue on a tablecloth or dripped paint on the carpet, you have never really lived... Brian



CAPEL-LE-FERNE PARISH COUNCIL

Summary of some items discussed at meeting held Tuesday, 15th July 2025



Requests from public and Other Feedback:

- Cut back of hedges on New Dover Road.
- Further bus shelter by Alexandra Road and a seat in shelter at Winehouse Lane.
- ➤ Bonfires at Lighthouse Inn.
- ➤ Abandoned caravan and fly tipping Old Dover Road. (Now removed).

Matters Concerning the Parish:

- ➤ Flooding Capel Street/Lancaster Avenue:
 - Councillors had carried out inspection of chambers. Still no response from Kent County Council (KCC). Further meetings planned of Kent Forum, Parish Council, and residents. Evidence of recent flooding in June recorded. Parish Council to seek advice from the Kent Association of Local Councils
- ➤ Health and Safety documents and Risk Assessments
 Ongoing monitoring of contractors' documents.
- ➤ Land Gifted to Parish Council
 Progress ongoing with Solicitors. Grass continues to be cut.
- ➤ <u>Damaged street pole</u> in New Dover Road being dealt with by UK Power Networks.
- ➤ <u>Pot holes/resurface Hurst Lane</u>, still waiting Kent Highways further investigations on defects.

Planning:

- Capel Court Park waiting Appeal Application to Government Inspectorate, on refusal decision by Dover District Council on Certificate of Lawfulness.
- ➤ <u>All planning application documents and comments</u>
 Available to view on Dover District Council website:

Neighbourhood Watch (NHW):

Community Warden report:

- ➤ Police involvement with victimised resident.
- ➤ Police were involved in death of elderly resident and concerns raised about dog in house. RSPCA visited and left dog overnight with food and water, collecting the dog for rehoming the next day.
- ➤ Water leak Capel Street, still under investigations.

CCTV/ICT:

- Following guidelines from Information Commissioner Office (ICO), request paperwork was deemed in place, to release CCTV footage of an incident at Village Hall.
- > Update/renewal of cameras to be investigated.

Playing Field and Equipment:

Annual Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents (RoSPA) inspection, of recreation equipment, carried out in July. Waiting reports.

Traffic Management and Highways:

- ➤ Lighting in Old Dover Road to be monitored further in October when clocks change.
- ➤ Vehicle activated signs on New Dover Road (B2011), still waiting design, location and costs involved from Kent Highways.

Traffic Management and Highways continued:

- ➤ Hedge in Capel Street cut back.
- ➤ Hurst Lane request for re-surface still being addressed with Kent Highways.
- ➤ Diversion signs on M20/A20, when Roundhill Tunnels closed, no response since December. District Councillor Hibbert to chase.

➤ <u>Public Rights of Way (PROW)</u>:

- ➤ Cllr. Lake written to KCC PROW on cycling on clifftop path and request for no cycling signage.
- ➤ Two wooden signposts broken and need replacing behind Church and Green Lane.

Speed Watch:

- ➤ To be known as Kent Eastern Region (KER) Speed Watch in future Minutes.
- ➤ Report given by Cllr. S Pilcher, on page 14, with recruitment details and chart leader details.
- ➤ Session results available on Parish Council Website. https://capellefernepc.org.uk

Kent resident targeted by Dash Cam Scam. They made an online purchase of 3 dash cams - with hindsight, they thought this might be a scam. They asked to cancel, but was told it was outside the cancellation period. The resident later received a parcel containing a bag of confectionary. Always do your research on a business and make sure they are who they say they are. Verify the website's security by looking for the padlock icon in the address bar and ensuring the URL starts with "https://". Stick to well-known and trusted online stores. Before buying from a new seller, especially on online marketplaces, check for reviews and feedback from other customers. For advice and to report contact Citizens Advice consumer helpline 0808 223 1133. If you have paid the criminals, call your bank immediately on 159 to report.

One local cat, Smokey, nearly died after being treated with a fake flea product bought online. The treatment looked real, but it contained a toxic insecticide. Smokey needed emergency surgery to survive. Do not let this happen to your pet. Buy only from trusted retailers Check packaging for errors Report anything suspicious

Doorstep Criminals target Ashford, Faversham, Herne Bay, Romney Marsh and Sevenoaks in one instance the resident paid by cheque for moss cleaning on their roof, but after writing the cheque they were told in should be made out to a different name. Both cheques were cashed by the criminal.

Do you or someone you know use a telecare alarm?

Landlines switching from analogue to digital could stop telecare alarms working, but landline providers can help. The switchover is already happening, so call the landline provider for support now. Telephone providers are upgrading the landline network, also known as the PSTN (Public Switched Telephone Network) from analogue to digital or IP (Internet Protocol), which means that in the future voice telephone calls will be carried in the same way as data over a broadband connection.

The switchover is happening now and for most the move will be straightforward. Nobody will have to lose their

landline service nor change their telephone number and,

in most cases, the existing handset will be compatible.

Summer slush warning: Glycerol in slush ice drinks unsafe for children under 7. At very high levels of exposure, typically when several servings of these products are consumed by a child in a short space of time, glycerol can cause shock, very low blood sugar levels and loss of consciousness. Product Details Summer slush drinks or "slushies" from machines and pouches. Containing: Glycerol (E422) Advice for consumers FSA advises that children aged 7 to 10 should have no more than one 350ml 'slushie' drink per day – roughly the size of a fizzy drink can. Parents should ask sellers whether drinks contain glycerol and review product labels or signage at point of sale. The FSA advises consumers to avoid products if they are unsure about ingredients and seek medical advice if a child develops symptoms.

A Kent resident lost several thousand pounds after paying for an online course linked to a money-making scheme they found on social media. Following the first 'mentoring session,' they felt misled and asked for a refund — but it was refused. If you are promised high returns that seem too good to be true, they probably are. Do not engage — if you have already started chatting, end the conversation. Always research the business. Do not trust reviews they show you — they could be fake. Need advice or want to report a scam? Call the Citizens Advice consumer helpline on 0808 223 1133.
