

The Farmer's Market is soldiering on. We have been trying to encourage community activities so this has been reflected in the various people who hold surgeries and visit us. The Parish Council has held a surgery on the first Tuesday of the month for a while now and we have recently had Paul King our KCC councillor in attendance. The Gardeners Association comes monthly and those working on the poppy tableau also pop in. Jan Henry, our Community Warden, is around from 11am most Tuesdays. Our stalls vary from week to week. Our meat, bread, cakes, honey, jam, eggs, jewellery, Cornish pasties, sausage rolls and meat pies are there every week. Our home-made cakes, cards and craft tables are there every other week while the French cheese stall (and pates, garlic, and other things français) is there on the first Tuesday on the month. We have a candlemaker who comes monthly and we are awaiting a new dog stall (that's food and accessories not the animal itself). If you want to sell anything, contact Sally as below. Over the last month we have been either giving away or selling gluts of fruit and vegetables grown by Capel residents. If you are interested in us doing this on your behalf, then either pop in and see us on a Tuesday morning at the hall, or give Sally a call on 077304 75838.

As you are reading this, the annual Garage Safari is just around the corner on Sunday, 7th September. Official start time is 9am but buyers have been known to turn up earlier. You have a few days to book a table by putting £5 in an envelope with your name and address on and dropping into Cherry Leppard at 29 Albany Road – or the Farmers' Market on a Tuesday. This is always a well-supported event by both residents and others from the local area. Parking is on the Parish Council land alongside the Hall and will be signed post and marshalled. The Village Hall kitchen will be open for bacon butties and cheese or ham rolls, with cakes and chocolate for those with a sweet tooth and plenty of tea, coffee and canned drinks.

Hot on the back of the Safari is the Community lunch on Saturday, 4th October, booking will be taken shortly. We are currently arranging a couple of sessions, provided by Kent Police, to heighten awareness of cyber security. These are about 40 minutes long and are free to attend. We are hoping for one morning and one evening slot so that all ages have the opportunity to attend... watch the



From the vicarage

The Book of Genesis makes it all sound so simple; when Abraham left home, he took his wife, his brother's son, their possessions, and their dependants, set off for Canaan, and that was it. But looking around my office and thinking of all that I have got to do before I take my wife, our son, our possessions and our dependants (cats, cockatiels, and tropical fish) and set off for retirement, it doesn't look as simple as all that - there's still so much to do.

It still feels early to be saying our goodbyes, but our time here – nearly thirteen years - is nevertheless drawing to a close, with my final service in the Parish at the end of September.

Many years ago, long before I was ordained, I was a server at the church that I used to attend. When the vicar left, he gave a long farewell speech, thanking everyone who had supported him in his ministry by name – except me! Someone noticed, and asked me how I felt about being left out. I answered – truthfully – that I hadn't needed him to say anything. He had never failed to show his appreciation for anything I had done.

I have been privileged to be the Parish Priest here. Our years here have been happy years, and I'm grateful for the love, prayers, and support that I have enjoyed from so many, both within our church families and also among the wider community. Whatever help anyone has given, I have appreciated it all - and I hope that I've shown it. Last word to St Paul:

Finally, brothers and sisters, farewell... The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you. Brian

f you are not yet a member and would like to be, membership is just a low £12.00 per year.


The society holds a Rose show in June, Spring, Summer and Autumn Shows, at the Village Hall. See "What's On" front page for dates.

'Warmer homes this winter and lower bills' – Free insulation, Solar PV and Air Source Heat Pumps

Dover District and Dartford Borough Councils working together have been awarded funding to support residents improve the energy efficiency of their homes. The money will be invested in homes across the district as part of the Warm Homes Local Grant (WHLG), funding the likes of loft insulation, cavity wall insulation, internal wall insulation for solid wall homes, air source heat pumps (ASHP) and Solar PV.

10 quality for funding the property and the occupants need to meet the criteria below: -

- The property has an EPC rating below a C. You can find out more about energy ratings https://www.gov.uk/findenergy-certificate (if you do not have an energy rating for your property you may still be eligible)
- The total annual household income (gross) is £36,000 or lower, or the occupants are in receipt of a means tested

The initiative is aimed at privately owned and privately rented properties in the district that meet the criteria (eligible private rented properties will require landlord agreement and a signed declaration form).
