On the 2nd December, the Village Hall will be holding its Annual General Meeting. Every year we elect our trustees, give out a general report on the previous year activities, and present the audited financial accounts. And every year we ask for your attendance and if interested, for your application to become a trustee. When I joined the committee just over 10 years ago, we had 14 trustees and quite a lot of volunteers. Through time the number of these has dwindled to a mere 7 with a stalwart but small group of volunteers behind us.

We do a lot; the Garage Safari, the Boot Fairs, the free Community Lunches, Christmas events, the honesty library, and the Farmers' Market, are all run by those 7 people. But we have other ideas too. We would like to do more community-based events, but until we get more trustees/volunteers these will not happen.

The Village Hall remains a hub for the Village, offering lots of different clubs including judo, youth club, Tai Chi, car club, bridge as well as hosting private events such as birthday parties and other celebrations.

The Hall belongs to the Village and its 2,000 plus residents. It would be wonderful to have some fresh blood, with new ideas, who can also support us in and at regular things that we do. Please come to your Village Hall on the 2nd December for the AGM, at 7pm, and where possible, volunteer to help us. I can promise you that you will enjoy it.

Coming up, we have the Boot Fair on 16th November and the Christmas Craft Day on the 6th December. We still have one or two spaces left, so contact Sally on 077304 75838 if interested.

The Christmas event starts at 12noon with the Craft Fair, and Santa will be in his grotto from 2pm with presents for the children. At 4pm, we pack to be ready for the lighting of the Tree from 4.45pm, with Carol singing led by the Capel choristers and the school choir. After this, Santa will depart from the car park on his sleigh to tour the Village. Please come out and cheer him on. The day is being co-ordinated by the Hall, working with the Parish Council and the Folkestone Hythe and District Lions Club. It should be a fun day out for everyone.

The group meets on the third Tuesday of each month at 7:30pm in St Radigund's Church, Albany Road, for informative presentations, social events and quiz evenings.



This is the National memorial and is dedicated to the few, who between 10th July and 31st October 1940, won the Battle of Britain. Five hundred men died or were lost in the battle; the average age was 20-22 years.

Karen Cross, last year's winner of the Pat Stoker Cup, judged the Swiss Rolls made by several members and declared Debbie Saunders the winner and presented her with the trophy. Members then enjoyed Swiss Roll with their tea and coffee at refreshment time.

Jan Ardley kindly organised the game Getting to Know You for member's time. This involves sitting in two lines opposite each other and then having a 2-minute chat about a given subject and then moving seats, so that you get to speak to a different person every time the subject changes. A great way to get to know new people and to maybe learn a bit more about those you already know.




